SIENNA BREEZE bumped with an inner rival at the start, pressed the leader from the three path, bid in upper stretch, gained an advantage entering the final furlong and held from a late outer challenger. WON DAY tracked in the four path, ran on and sustained gradual progress to bid outside of the leader in the final sixteenth, but just missed. COPPER MOON bumped with an outer foe leaving the gate, showed the way in the two path, but got headed by an outer bidder in midstretch and yielded. COMMERCIAL FLASH broke slowly, trailed while tucking to the inside into the turn, then saved ground to no avail. MYFRIENDSAWINNER chased a little off of the inside, shifted out to the five path into the lane and failed to factor. DR STRICKLANDS ACE was fractious in the starting gate, raced off of the pace in the three path, fanned out to the six path into the lane and made little impact.

MIGHTY ERIU (IRE) pressed outside of the leader, vied nearing the lane, gained an advantage at the three sixteenths pole and drove clear. I'M MO JOKE stalked along the inside, moved out to the three path in upper stretch, gained place in midstretch then chased the clear leader home and held place. MISS DEMANDING laid off of the pace in the two path, shifted out to the six path in upper stretch and rallied to gain show in the final sixteenth. BETTY'S DANCE tracked three wide, floated to the five path in upper stretch, chased and forged show at the furlong grounds but got outkicked by an outer rival late. EXINGTON tracked two wide and between horses, chased floating to the four path in upper stretch and lacked a bid. DON'T BE SALTY dropped back to spot the rest of the field multiple lengths early on, trailed along the inside and made little impact. DON'T BLINK set the pace inside of a prompting rival, got headed by that one in upper stretch and weakened.

CARSON BAY showed the way inside of a prompting GOLDEN IRISH, dueled with that bidder turning for home, repelled that challenge entering the final furlong, shook free and held sway. GOLDEN IRISH bumped an outer foe leaving the gate, pressed outside of the eventual winner and from the three path, bid sparring a duel with five sixteenths to go, vied through upper stretch, but failed to maintain even terms nearing the furlong grounds, kept on thereafter but was fended off. BLACK GINGER pursued from midpack in the four to three path, chased while drifting out to the seven path in midstretch, yet ran on in the final furlong to reach gain at the wire. AUTUMN RHYTHM took light contact from an inner rival at the start, chased closest to the top pair from the three path, sustained pursuit moving out to the five path in midstretch, then stayed on whlie meeting a late outer challenge for show but got nailed at the wire. RARE RUBY leaned inwardly at the start, saved ground off of the pace and gave way. MAX'S REDEMPTION transferred contact from an inner rival to an outer foe at the start, trailed in the three path, moved out to the six path into the lane and was outrun.

YANKEESTROLOGY laid off of the pace in the four path, crept closer in the four to five path turning for home to be within striking range of the new leader in upper stretch, flopped back to his left lead while chasing into the final furlong, sustained gradual progress to issue a late bid and got up at the wire. SMART IZZY was brushed between rivals soon after the start, trailed along the inside, then in the two path around the far turn, advanced between horses entering the lane, sustained rail progress to bid inside of the leaders in the final furlong and edged past. RUSTY'S SUNRISE was briefly antsy just before the off, set the pace tucking from the two path to the inside around the first turn, held sway from outer pressers around the far turn, but got headed by an outer bidder while moving out to the three path in upper stretch, drifted about yet fought on between horses as an inner bidder joined the fray in the final furlong but got outkicked. MO SMOKING brushed with an inner rival early on, laid off of the pace in the three path, moved out to the five path around the far turn before floating to the six path into the lane, yet ran on outside of the leaders and gained show at the wire. BROADWAY PEARL stalked two wide, split foes to move alongside of the top pair turning for home, bid in the four path entering the lane, led but drifted out in upper stretch, then yielded between horses late and got nailed for show. VIV'S WILD ACES prompted outside of the leader, came under urging to sustain pressure around the far turn, but got outkicked by an outer rival leaving the quarter pole and gave way. PRETTY PRAIRIE stalked along the inside, took aim outside of the leader entering the lane, bid in upper stretch, wrestled an advantage while dueling into the final furlong and maintained that advantage from her inner stubborn counterpart. SMITTYS CHEETAH set the pace in the two path, built a clear advantage into the turn, but was collared by an outer bidder in upper stretch, got headed while dueling in midstretch, fought on doggedly through the final furlong but was kept at bay then saved place. LADY STAR lacked speed two wide, rallied inside of rivals into the final furlong, gained show from outer foes while moving out to the four path passing the sixteenth pole, then closed in on the top pair late and missed place. ESKENFORAVE AND AK brushed with an outer rival and bumped firmly with an inner foe at the start, raced off of the pace in the three path, fanned out to the six path entering the lane, rallied before being floated wider by inner drifting foes at the sixteenth pole and secured fourth. SASSI IDOL tracked in the four path, chased in the five path into the turn, ran on but shied from an inner rival into an outer foe's path at the sixteenth pole and kept on evenly. TENSAS BOLT tracked two wide and between horses, chased in the two to three path into midstretch, but was floated out by an inner rival into outer foes at the sixteenth pole and gave way. OCEAN VOW broke a step slow, saved ground in midpack, moved out to the four path in upper stretch before being briefly put to tight quarters between foes at the three sixteenths pole, then drifted in and chased mildly. LITTLEBITOFAQUEEN raced at the rear in the four path and failed to

factor. MO HAY BABY brushed with an inner rival leaving the gate, raced off of the pace in the four to five path, floated to the seven path into the lane and tired. TOO SPICY broke slowly, raced off of the pace along the inside and got outrun.

TONTERRIA pursued from midpack in the two to three path, rallied between horses to bid outside of the leader in the final sixteenth and edged past. STAR READY pressed in the four to three path, bid turning for home, led entering upper stretch, but drifted in leaving the three sixteenths pole, bumped and bothered TAKEOVER FIFTYFOUR nearing midstretch, straightened course and held sway into the final sixteenth, but was caught by an outer bidder late and lasted for place. IRON MOON saved ground off of the pace, encountered traffic in the two to three path in upper stretch, pursued in tight quarters among foes into the final furlong, altered out, ran on between horses and was gaining on the top pair late but ran out of ground. TAKEOVER FIFTYFOUR stalked tucking to the inside into the backstretch, awaited racing room behind the leaders around the far turn, took rail aim in upper stretch, but was bumped by an outer STAR READY leaving the three sixteenths pole, steadied and lost momentum entering the final furlong, then kept on willingly. GAME AND GORMLEY bobbed slightly at the start, tracked along the inside, ranged up outside of the leading pair and from the four path turning for home, bid while

drifting to the six path entering the lane, but failed to reach even terms with inner rivals in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, then yielded while lugging out in the final sixteenth. PLAY MASTER bobbed slightly and tossed his head at the start, lacked speed in the three to two path, checked behind a rival entering the final sixteenth and lacked a bid. JACKSON D raced off of the pace in the three to four path, moved out to the five path into the lane and tired. STONE ALLIANCE was outrun along the inside. NERVY showed the way in the three to two path, but got headed by an outer presser entering the lane and weakened between horses. THE RIDER OF TAKEOVER FIFTYFOUR CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST STAR READY ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH. FOLLOWING THE OBJECTION AS WELL AS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REVIEWING THE SAME MATTER, STAR READY WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FOURTH
