GRABIQ took light contact from an outer rival leaving the gates, settled well back in the two path, picked up stride in the four to five path turning for home, rallied in the six path in upper stretch, bid along with an inner SWEET ALEXIS at the sixteenth pole, dueled with that one thereafter and prevailed. LOVE AND POETRY laid off of the pace in the two path, tracked in the three path turning for home, tipped to take aim four wide in upper stretch, bid before wrestling a narrow advantage at the furlong grounds, but was outkicked by an outer bidder in the final sixteenth. PLAY WITH FIRE tracked along the inside, ranged up three wide around the far turn to bid and forge an advantage entering the lane, but was subtly headed by an outer bidder at the furlong grounds and yielded to the top pair late. ATERRADORA (IRE) vied along the inside before backing off to stalk around the first turn, pursued from the pocket around the far turn, chased two wide into the lane and lacked a bid. LADY ORIENT stalked three to two wide, bid around the far turn, but got outkicked by an outer challenger entering the lane and gave way. MERRY AND BRIGHT led narrowly two wide into the first turn before crossing over to the inside entering the backstretch, met an outer challenge around the far turn, got headed at the five sixteenths pole and weakened in upper stretch.

LIAM'S MIST broke a beat slow, recovered to stalk forwardly three wide, proved no match for the leader entering the lane, yielded place while floating out at the furlong grounds and lost show late. BAYTOWN BOUJEE brushed with an outer rival at the start, lacked speed in the three path then failed to menace between horses. BAYOU CHICK raced off of the pace while hung in the five path and failed to facto. TDZ DANCINLILSLEW pursued in the four path and between horses but made little impact. BELLA SORELLA trailed in the two path, shifted out to the seven path in upper stretch and got outrun. WELL ACCUSTOMED stalked two wide along with an outer rival, but proved no match for the leader entering the lane and caved in hand.
