WAYSIDE DRIVE pressed two wide, gained an advantage while getting floated to the three path entering the lane, sparred with an inner bidder in upper stretch, drifted out multiple paths while clinging to an advantage at the furlong grounds, straightened course a sixteenth out and drove clear. SOUTHSCAPE broke a step slow at the start, laid off of the pace in the three path, swung out to the six path entering the lane and rallied to gain place at the wire. TENSAS CAMP ROAD stalked along the inside, awaited racing room from the pocket around the far turn, slipped through once the leader vacated the rail entering the lane, bid inside of the new leader passing the quarter pole, vied as his counterpart bore out in midstretch, but was repelled with a sixteenth go and got nailed by an outer bidder for place. EMILY'S BOY was bumped by an inner rival at the start, tracked in the three path, chased in the two path around the far turn, tipped out to the four path while between rivals entering the lane and pursued evenly. CHASTE ONE tracked along the inside, chased in upper stretch, but hung on his left lead and gave way. BLAME ME SERIOUSLY saved ground off of the pace, but to no avail. MR. FAVERSHAM lacked speed along the inside, came under a right handed crop while inching closer approaching the far turn, gained in the three path around that bend before fanning out to the five path entering the lane, sustained his rally to gain an advantage at the furlong grounds and held sway from an inner persistent counterpart. ALL WEST pressed the leader from the four path around the first turn, vied while floated to the five path into the backstretch, sparred shoulder to shoulder while moving inwardly into the far turn, dueled in the two path around that bend, led in the three path entering the lane, dug in as an outer pair took aim in upper stretch, got headed by his widest challenger at the furlong grounds, fought on doggedly through the late stages but was kept at bay. SMOOTHDINI had his hind heels clipped while crossing across an inner rival's path into the first turn, pursued from midpack in the two path, advanced between horses before inching closer in the three to four path into the lane, took aim along with an outer rival in upper stretch, but got outkicked then turned away for place in the final furlong. KEYS INCLUDED clipped a rival's hind heels when that one cut across his path into the first turn, recovered and trailed two wide into the backstretch, then in the three to five path into the lane, floated out to the eight path in midstretch and improved position. OVERANALYTICAL showed the way in the three path as an outer ALL WEST applied pressure, moved further off of the inside as that one moved to vie into

the backstretch, sparred shoulder to shoulder while getting floated inwardly by his outer counterpart into the far turn, dueled along the rail while headed turning for home and gave way in upper stretch. OVER CALENDARED stalked along the inside, chased around the far turn and faded. PATH TO SUCCESS tracked in the three path, faded in the four to six path nearing the lane and was eased thereafter. START SINGING broke a half beat slow, laid off of the pace in the three to four path into the backstretch, gained in the four path around the far turn, progressed to bid in upper stretch and drove clear at the furlong grounds. DASHYNS DREAM laid off of the pace in the three path, was roused to the four path turning for home, fanned to the five path entering the lane, rallied to gain place at the sixteenth pole and was second best. IM SINGLED UP was bumped between horses at the start, pursued from midpack a touch off of the inside, came under urging saving ground around the far turn, chased into midstretch, then moved up between horses late. PASTA SALAD RHONDA brushed an inner foe before steadying back at the start, raced well back two wide, then in the three path around the far turn before swinging to the six path entering the lane, ran on to issue a bid for show in the final sixteenth, but hung late and saved fourth. MRS. NECAISE stalked in the three to four path, rallied to drive past the leader nearing midstretch and drew clear. ASTROLOGY GIRL set a clear pace, got headed by an outer rival nearing midstretch while hanging on her left lead, changed leads between rivals shortly after then fought on to hold place. SABERFIGHT chased forwardly just off of the inside, ran on to bid for place three wide in the final furlong but hung. REAL DEAL RYAN saved ground off of the pace, ran on to vie for place with an outer pair through the final furlong but was denied. LITTLE Z broke a step slow, trailed in the three path then ran on willingly. ANSLIE'S GUMDROP pursued from the three path and between horses, chased in the four path into the lane, tipped outwardly then failed to menace. DIAMOND DEAL tracked in the four path, chased while drifting to the six path entering the lane and gave way. TIME TO CLOSE raced off of the pace in the five to seven path and failed to factor. TAKEN IT hopped at the start, lacked speed in the four path and got outrun.
