AMPITUP set the pace inside of a prompter into the turn, led narrowly from that bidder and a wider challenger turning for home, clung to an advantage before shaking clear while hanging on his left lead at the furlong grounds, changed leads entering the final sixteenth and held sway. DEAL OF FAITH stalked three wide, bid turning for home, floated to the four path entering the lane, yet ran on to sustain his challenge in the final furlong but was kept at bay. SPRINGTOWN prompted two wide into the turn, bid along with an outer foe at the five sixteenths pole, spun into the lane in the three path while vying between horses, but yielded in the final furlong. E LION broke slow and spotted the leaders multiple lengths at the start, raced well back in the five path, launched a rally in the six path into the lane and gained place in the final sixteenth. RESTORE (FR) dueled for the lead two wide, sparred gamely with his inner counterpart into the final furlong, but got outkicked by an outer challenger at the sixteenth pole, then yielded yet narrowly lasted for show. AMBIVALENT tracked in the four path, inched closer while fanning to the six path entering the lane, took aim on the new leader before offering a bid in upper stretch, sparked a duel entering the final furlong and gradually edged past. FELIX broke a beat slow, prompted outside of the top pair before vying with them while hung in the five path around the turn, wrestled an advantage turning for home, led as an outer foe took aim in upper stretch, gamely sparred with that bidder into deep stretch but was bested late. GILDED RULER raced off of the pace in the two to three path, shifted out to the five to six path in midstretch while running on, then moved up to gain show at the wire. KAVOD got outbroke by an outer rival, shifted out and rushed forward to vie outside of that one early on, sparred in the four path and between rivals around the turn, got headed by his outer counterpart at the five sixteenths pole, yielded approaching midstretch then lost show at the wire. UNCLE BERLEY trailed in the three to four path, floated out to the seven path in midstretch and improved willingly. SON OF A BIRCH stalked along the inside, chased into the lane, lacked a bid and got outkicked by outer rivals late. HONKY TONK HIGHWAY vied for the lead with a pair of outer rivals into the turn, yielded to them nearing the lane, kept on in pursuit through midstretch but weakened through the final sixteenth.

KALIL bumped an inner rival at the start, stalked three deep, assumed command via a bold bid at the quarter pole and drew off under mild urging. JUS MAKES CENTS was briefly antsy in the starting gate before breaking a step slow, recovered to stalk close up along the inside, slipped through to forge place leaving the furlong pole and held from an outer bidder. AWREE pursued from midpack in the three path, chased in the three to four path turning for home before floating to the five path into the lane, then ran on to miss place at the wire. THATS UNBELIEVABLE brushed with an outer foe leaving the gate, raced off of the pace along the inside, shifted out to the five path into the lane and moved up. LITTLEBITOFAQUEEN brushed with an outer foe leaving the gate before grazing an inner foe soon after the start, raced off of the pace in the two to three path, fanned out to the six path into the lane and improved position. MO DIVA brushed with an inner foe leaving the gate, set the pace along the inside, got headed by the eventual winner leaving the quarter pole and weakened. DREAMCHASER JEWELS broke outwardly and bumped a foe at the start, raced well back three wide and failed to factor. DELIGHTFUL HALO brushed with an inner foe at the start, pressed two wide, chased between horses turning for home and weakened. FRISEE was pinched between rivals and steadied back at the start, trailed in the three to two path and got outrun. REMEMBERIN RONALD was put to tight quarters among foes soon after the start, tracked in teh two to four path into the backstretch, then weakened in the five path around the far turn.
