VOILA MAGIC broke well, settled just behind THE WICKED CAT initially, then ranged up in hand and took command midway through the turn, then drew off through the stretch under steady handling while drifting out a bit in the late stages. WICKED AS HAGGART broke outward at the start, settled back early, advanced under a drive through the turn, bid about six wide into the stretch, then finished up well to move up into second despite lugging in through the stretch. YORKTOWN PANTHER had to be ridden to keep pace early, went evenly through the stretch, outlasted the rest to take home the minor award. THE WICKED CAT broke on top and went clear through the initial furlong, was challenged by VOILA MAGIC after passing the half, then gave way to that one midway through the turn and was outfinished in the stretch. CLEARLY MAJESTIC raced close up just behind the pacesetters through the early stages without a clear path through the inside, swung out four-wide into the stretch, but faltered. ASTHECOLDWINDBLOWS got away slower than the others and chased wide throughout. CHEETAH LADY was unhurried from the start, and settled along the rail at the back of the compact field, tipped out to the three-path into the far turn to set up a four-wide bid at the head of the stretch, had some trouble changing leads while dueling with STORM MIAMI (IRE), but got a head in front inside the sixteenth to prevail. STORM MIAMI (IRE) settled just behind DOUDOUDOUWANADANCE through the early stages, took over the lead near the five-sixteenths marker, dug in when confronted by CHEETAH LADY in upper stretch, battled gamely to the wire but came up short in the end. MO EXPECTATIONS settled in cover in the middle of the pack, then finished well up the rail to gain third. PISCIOTTA (GB) stumbled at the start, settled three-wide near the rear, moved up closer on the far turn, then put in a steady run to the finish, altered course near the furlong pole, but could not crack the top three. PRETTY SASSY settled at the back but not far off the pace through the first half-mile, rallied three-wide through the far turn, sustained the bid through the stretch, finished with interest but was not quite good enough despite a solid effort. CHANTILLY ROAD became a bit keen going into the first turn, then pulled to be up close four-wide down the backstretch, loomed a threat approaching the quarter pole, but went flat in the stretch and failed to menace. DOUDOUDOUWANADANCE broke well and inherited the early lead, slowed the pace through the first half-mile, fought back under threat into the far turn, then started to weaken approaching the quarter pole, was dropping back, then took up sharply before the stretch, lost momentum, and was eased to the finish line, and walked off.

TEDDER hustled up after a bit of a tardy start, tracked three-wide just behind the pace battle, tipped out four-wide into the stretch, engaged in a spirited stretch battle with ACKLEY through the stretch, gained the advantage just inside the sixteenth marker, and prevailed. COWBOY ROY broke on top but ceded the lead to WALKERS CREEK, was without a clear path through the turn, but came on strong in the final furlong and just missed while lugging out near the wire. ACKLEY was allowed to settle from the start, then ranged up three-wide, took over the past the three-furlong pole, still in-hand, battled back when challenged by TEDDER in upper stretch, then weakened a bit in the final yards. YINZER pressed the pace three-wide from the outset, moved up to challenge LEGALIZE on lead approaching the quarter pole, dueled outside of that foe through the stretch while pulling clear from the rest, drifted in under right-handed urging and made contact with that rival before the finish. LEGALIZE had

good speed from the break and seized the lead before the first turn, led the way down the backstretch with a couple of rivals in close pursuit, but was left to dictate the pace, quickened into the far turn, then set down with YINZER in the stretch, dueled gamely, was put in tight and bumped in the final yards. FOLIGNO took a bump at the start, then settled in the back half of the field through the early stages, then moved up late on the back stretch to join the main pack, then finished up strong to win the race for the minor award. ENLIGHTEN broke out and bumped FOLIGNO at the start, then raced in mid-pack to the far turn, swung five-wide into the stretch, and rallied to improve despite racing a bit erratically in deep stretch. WENDELSSOHN got away well, tracked behind the pace down the backstretch, then followed KOMOREBINO OMOIDE (JPN) into the stretch, wore down that rival by mid-stretch, edged clear and held a slight advantage to the wire. KOMOREBINO OMOIDE (JPN) broke well, tracked the early pace two-deep, moved confidently to bid for the lead near the five-sixteenths marker, dueled with WENDELSSOHN from upper stretch, but gave way in the final furlong and had to settle for the place. THE DONEGAL CLAN broke well but was under a ride from the outset to keep pace, saved ground to the stretch, then finished well to win the race for third. F T W SLAM settled four-wide in the second flight, advanced on the leaders through the turn to bid for the lead five-wide at the top of the stretch, and drew away in the late stages. CONEJO CHAPIN raced between horses in the tracking group, advanced closer through the turn, but was without a clear path approaching the stretch, tipped out to the three path, could not get to the winner, but moved up to gain the place. AVERY'S GEM pressed the early pace three-wide, took the lead midway through the turn, took a short lead into the stretch, held on well, but was outfinished by the top pair. RAZOR CREST was slow to begin and trailed well behind the field early, but finished up well to improve. YOCKEY'S DRIVETHRU raced in the middle of the pack through the early stages, finished with interest but could not find a winning kick in the late stages. MYGLORYBEE settled back, then angled out five-wide late on the turn, kept on well but was unable to threaten. LAURI'S WISH was briefly up in the early pace battle, backed off heading into the turn, and was unable to regain momentum. LOUISIANA JESS contested the early pace three-deep to the stretch, then tied. POP'S PEPPYSTEPER was the inside horse in the early speed battle, gave way in upper stretch, and faded to last.
