DEPUTY TRAMON In hand along the three path, two path around, appeared to be blocked into the lane, waited, was cut loose when clear, took the advantage and edged clear. RESISTANCE FUTILE Vied for the lead, between at the top of the lane, battled and finished well. SUPPORT THE CAT Close up four wide into the turn, launched a bid to challenge from between three deep at the top of the lane, battled outside and weakened. FIRST SONS Broke sluggishly, five wide well placed into the turn, challenged four across while five wide at the top of the lane and faded. JUST A GUY Broke sluggishly, vied for the lead along the rail to the lane and tired. EIGHT SUNSET DRIVE Trailed without mishap. SHARPOON Two path into the turn, six wide leaving it and finished wide.
