GO LAUREN GO broke alertly, showed the way up the backstretch off the inside, continued to hold the advantage through the stretch, held the runner up at bay through the stretch under steady handling. LADY FOR THE MONEY forwardly placed inside the winner, chased that one out of the turn and into the stretch, could do little with the winner to the wire. DA LAST TEQUILA within striking distance outside, raced four wide through the turn, proved no match for the top two in the drive, finished up best of the rest. WILD SUN FLOWER broke back, moved up under encouragement out of the chute, fell back off the issue into the turn, went evenly through the final quarter. IRISH WRIT lacked early foot, continued back, improved from between rivals late without posing a serious threat. R TWO R BADFIT in the second flight, checked up in traffic into the turn, fell back and was not a threat through the lane. GOSPEL STUNNING made little impact while racing off the inside.
