PRECIOUS CARGO allowed the leaders to go early, continued in the second flight while four wide first turn, began to real that lead pack in after three furlongs, took control three wide into the lane, shook clear and held that advantage to the wire. GOSPEL JOURNEY with the early leaders down the stretch the first time, continued to vie through the first turn, raced on equal terms briefly inside the winner secon turn, gave ground grudgingly to that one through the lane. HOPKINSVILLE set or forced the pace while along the inside, held a narrow advantage out of the first turn and onto the backstretch, failed to keep up with the top two the final quarter mile, lasted for the show. CODE ELEVEN in the second flight outside the winner early, five wide through the first turn, went evenly thereafter in lacking a closing response. GOSPEL DON showed some early foot while outside, gradually weakened. EURA HAPPY HIPPIE broke back and made little impact. SON OF PREACHERMAN void of early foot, continued back and was never involved.
