SISSUE bobbled at the break, quickly recovered to press the winner from along the inside the opening quarter, began a steady retreat early in the turn. WITCH WAY GRAY broke on top, showed the way out of the chute, set a pressured pace up the backstretch in the two path, disposed of that inner rival early in the turn then held the runner up at bay through the lane under steady handling. COIN PURSE settled off the pace and the inside, lacked a closing response when called on for the drive. KIRBYS DEWDROP in the second flight outside, ranged up closer in the three path outside the winner turning for home, flattened out a bit through the lane, lacked further gain. AFRAID IM NOTCENTS last away, void of early foot, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while never a serious threat. ITSONLYMONEYHONEY settled off the pace following the start, closer three wide into the stretch the first time, rated the middle quarter while remaining outside, moved to the front with a sudden burst three wide into the third and final turn, quickly drew far clear to prove much the best while ridden out. STOLEN KISSES broke well from between horses, showed the way into the first turn, relinquished the advantage into the lane the first time, stalked inside, asked closer late backstretch, steadied when in a bit tight along the rail into the final bend, kicked clear of the other rival while no match for the winner. DREAM PRINCESS back off the early leader, took control after a quarter from between horses, set the pace the middle half off the inside, steadied between horses when the winner sped by with a quarter to run and gave way. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

OSAGE EXPRESS broke on top, set a pressured pace along the inside, continued to hold a narrow advantage the middle quarter, responded when challenged through the final turn, remained gamely involved down the stretch to miss. HOLY AMA pressed the runner up from the outside from the start, moved on equal terms with that one into the far turn, long duel to the wire, outnoddod by that same rival to narrowly miss the place while between the top two at the wire. DIAMOND GAL settled off the pace, continued evenly throughout in lacking a serious closing response. SURE THING SAMURAI broke back, lacked speed throughout and failed to menace. MAMIE D broke in and steadied, remained back to be always outrun. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

GOSPEL FOREST forwardly placed and three wide around the first turn, put a head in front entering the stretch the first time, continued to battle up front, fell back off the other two pacesetters after three quarters, came back to save the show while no threat to the top two late.
