OH I GIGGLE stalked the pace top trio, made a three to four wide bid and finished second best. DOC'S JOY pressed the early pace between rivals and weakened through the drive. TALL TALE dropped back early on, raced in tight quarters nearing the eighth pole and was even with no final bid. VANALEE set a pressured early pace along the inside and faded. MOLLYS MIA raced three to four wide and had no late response. SECRET CITY showed little. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time.

ITSNOTMYJOB set all the pace and prevailed late under strong handling. PEACH STREET under a hard chase, raced two to three wide and was closing in late to just miss. OUR CLOVER GAL raced three to four wide around the far turn and moved up to improve position. CHACHA TO CATALINA squeezed back at the start, had a two to three wide run and moved up mildly late. TIZ HOPPIN urged from the inside and weakened. ADDI BUG broke awkwardly, raced off the early going after the poor start, raced five wide into the upper stretch and never threatened. HOT TUB HOTTIE checked sharply at the start, saved ground through the far turn and never threatened. TAP THE HEART saved ground and never threatened.
