IMMORAL prompted the pace four wide between rivals, continued with the winner to late in the far turn and could not match strides. MONGOLIAN MOON rallied inside and gained the show late. CONTACT TRACING moved up four wide going to the far turn and made a mild bid in the lane. AUDACE moved up three wide but could not threaten late. TOSKA'S RULER brushed and was shuffled back when in tight into the first turn and had no rally. MARQUEE THUNDER brushed with a rival into the first turn while showing speed and weakened. EPIC DRAMA was always back four wide. GOLDENLUTE hesitated at the break, vied from four wide early and tired. LUCKY BREAK tired racing four wide. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time available.
