EL ARE EM broke inward to bump with a rival, quickly rallied four wide going up the backstretch to bid into the far turn, drew clear then was roused in the lane to draw off. GOIN OWEN bump with a rival at the start, moved three or four wide to bid going up the backstretch, continued on to gain clear for the place but could not handle the winner. GAME'S KARTEL showed speed two or three wide to the far turn and came up empty in the lane. ONE LUCKY BOY showed speed along the inside, settled back going up the backstretch to angle out in the far turn and regained position in the lane. LITTLEBIT DON was bumped and squeezed back at the start, saved ground and made a mild run in the lane. ROCKETSHIP RUN stalked the pace from three or four wide and weakened. LUCKY LIQUOR SHOT trailed. JACHA was on the pace out from the rail, kicked well clear in the far turn and moved off under steady handling in the lane. DUBAIAN MONEY was along the inside just off the early pace, got nearest the winner while angling out in the lane but could not close the gap. STUNNEM saved ground and moved up through the far turn but could not threaten late. THUSLY INSPIRED tracked the winner's pace from four wide and weakened. ROMAN GENERAL moved four wide but lacked a closing bid in the lane. GABRIEL'S LEGEND was four and five wide in the first turn and moved up but did not threaten. SHARMA'D was five wide in the first turn, moved to bid outside heading up the backstretch and weakened. GEM COLLECTION was not a factor. RED CHEEKS showed early speed three wide and tired. ZEN STATE followed the pace from four wide and was finished early. This race was originally hand timed and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time.
