REDFIELD tapped on the brakes while headstrong in behind runners heading into and on the first turn, finally settled down off the pace stalking while kept wide, was forced out a bit bumping a rival lightly late up the backstretch, moved out and advanced four wide on the far turn taking the lead about the five-sixteenths, moved clear coming to the top of the stretch, held sway and was eased up near the wire. GOVENOR HANK pressed the early pace, took the lead about the three-quarters, was pressured soon after by outside rivals racing near but off the fence, was overtaken on the far turn, kept on in the lane switching out a bit, was no match for the winner but held the place. COOLTHING stalked from outside, moved between foes three wide three furlongs out to reach contention, was outkicked. MAASAI WARRIOR moved out, made an early move outside foes up the backstretch making a mild brief bid at the five- and one-half, weakened late. AMERICAN CAUSE led them early along the inside with brief speed, dropped back, shifted out and came into the stretch about five wide, failed to threaten late. MERLOTTI got away a step slowly, lacked speed, raced outside moving up heading up the backstretch, was bumped light and was never a threat.

TOO MUCH TUESDAY stalked from outside going three to four wide on the turn, bid at the quarter pole, was in command coming to the to of the stretch, lugged in a bit at the three-sixteenths having just moved clear, maintained well through mid-stretch and just lasted over a late-closing rival. AWESOME SUNDAY exchanged incidental contact at the start, settled off the pace kept wide, went three to four deep into and on the turn, came out of that bend six to seven wide, finished strongly and was gaining on the winner but just missed. SASSY WALKER raced in behind the top two up close tracking, made a bid up the inside coming to the quarter pole, could not kick on with the top ones, came out a bit in the stretch, needed more late. BIG SALLY set the pace while kept very wide in the early going, moved nearer the inside but still off the fence heading into the turn, was challenged by foes inside and out coming to the quarter pole and soon overtaken, switched out at the top of the stretch, offered no late bid. HER NAME WAS LOLA exchanged minor brushing at the start, angled in at the half, saved ground to no avail. SCRAPPY PATCH broke a step slowly, lacked early speed, failed to menace.

SHIP IT got away well, ceded the lead shortly after to stalk, advanced willingly on the turn to take the lead at the five-sixteenths, moved clear by the quarter pole, was mildly challenged in mid-stretch turning back that foe and kept on to hold sway. BLAZE BEAUTY shifted in late up the backstretch, saved some ground early on the turn before gradually moving out, fanned eight to nine wide for the drive, was gaining late to get up for place. TORTUGA ISLAND settled into stride then steadily advanced heading into the turn, went four wide through the turn getting to within striking distance by the quarter pole but could not make further headway and lost place late. MISS TENA MARIE was a bit keen up th backstretch racing off the inside, continued well back of the leaders in the two to three path through the turn, failed to menace but improved position. JAMAICAN TRAFFIC settled inside at the rear, switched out at the half racing off the rail about three wide into the turn ,swung nine wide into upper stretch, altered inside a rival at that juncture, was not a threat. GOLD SMOKE tucked in settling off the pace racing in the two to three path early, advanced outside a foe early on the far turn, was guided nearer inward leaving that bend cutting the corner into upper stretch with room up the inside, bid in mid-stretch taking the lead outside the sixteenth pole, moved clear and held while being kept to the task. CATEGORY TEN pressed from the outset, moved a narrow lead about the nine-sixteenths, was challenged by an outside foe while racing off the fence, turned that one away to be clear coming into upper stretch but was outkicked. BOOGIE BODE was caught five wide entering the first turn racing just off the pace but soon dropping back and tucking in a path, moved back out coming out of that bend, stalked from outside up the backstretch, was encouraged along past the five-sixteenths still racing four to five deep, kept on evenly in the lane, was no match for the top pair but captured show honors. SAINT GHAALEB was bumped into a foe soon after the start, soon moved to the lead, set the pace, was off the rail and clear coming into upper stretch, asked outside the furlong grounds and responded kicking on well clear as much the best. I DID THE MATH was bumped twice at the start, settled off the pace and off the rail, shifted out gradually leaving the turn, was six wide in upper stretch, ran on to be second best. RAZ ON FIRE settled outside mid-pack, advanced moderately on the turn four to six wide, ran on in the stretch but needed more. MIDNIGHT DATE tucked in up the backstretch settling off the pace in the three to four path, kicked on mildly to improve position in the stretch. SHE'S TAKIN CHARGE bumped with a rival after the start, moved forward up the backstretch but steadied on heels about the nine-sixteenths, appeared to be having trouble cornering late on the turn and was getting out, moved nearer the rail for the stretch run, failed to rally. HOOTIE HOOT was forwardly-positioned chasing into the turn, went three wide on that bend in range, was asked for more about the five-sixteenths, drifted a bit in upper stretch, weakened. IMA MIDNIGHT LADY had some bumps at the start, was well back at the raer along the inside and outrun. SHAMELESS GLAMOUR bumped a rival twice at and just after the start, was off the pace kept wide in the four to five path through the turn, failed to rally. HOT T'MATER had a strong bump just after the start, tracked in behind then was guided out about the five-eighths, advanced four wide into the turn, faltered in the stretch. REYANNO ROYAL bumped a rival lightly at the start, showed brief early speed then steadily retreated.
