LUCKY BOSS laid in range along the inside, was coaxed along around the far turn, had to steady at the top of the lane, floated out to the seven path passing the eighth pole, and stayed on to draw clear of an inner pair in the final sixteenth. BROWN RESERVE set the pace in the two path, lost the lead at the top of the stretch, dug in to regain the lead just after the eighth pole, but was overtaken by an outer foe in the final sixteenth. LEMON DROP SHOT stalked in the six path, bid in the four path around the far turn, kept on to lead at the top of the lane, but flattened in the final sixteenth. ETERNALLY GRATEFUL got herded out at the start, tracked in the four path but flattened in the six path down the stretch. BOOGIE BODE bumped with an inner foe at the start, chased in the five path but faded. COALMINER'S KITTEN broke out at the start, rated in the three path but weakened. RUNWITHHEART pressed between foes in the three path but yielded down the lane. DICK BEST prompted the pace in the four path but gave way in the stretch. BEEALEA bumped with an outer foe at the start, then always trailed around the seven path.
