KISSES FOR WEEJ got away well, was forwardly-positioned stalking from outside just off the flank of the leader, was floated about six wide by that one leaving the turn and commencing a bid, took the lead in mid-stretch, held from a late-closing NELLA, who was bumped at the start, settled at the back, advanced outside foes on the turn five to six wide, came into upper stretch seven, gained steadily but just missed. IRISH SPARK advanced inside on the turn, raced in behind off the fence leaving the bend, kept on inside foes late to annex show honors. PASSING PASSION was prominent just briefly, dropped off the lading pair and chased those from outside, came into upper stretch five wide, ran on but needed more to threaten. TAXDAY PEYTON broke a bit awkwardly, was urged forward, soon led inside setting the pace, was shadowed on the turn, drifted five wide coming out of that bend and was challenged, yielded late. MIDNIGHT DATE settled well back off the inside, shifted in on the turn coming into upper stretch inside, kicked on mildly inside. SHE'S TAKIN CHARGE bumped a rival at the start, chased from off the pace inside, shifted out late on the turn coming into upper stretch eight wide, faded. LAUREN'S WAR was outrun and never near enough to threaten.

ZEE FIRE was caught four wide on the first turn, moved to the rail then back out for the second turn, went four to five deep on that bend beginning to advance, took aim five to six wide in upper stretch, gained steadily to take the lead near the sixteenth pole and drew clear. TRAITOUR moved to the lead into the first turn, set the pace from outside moving clear after a quarter, continued from off the inside widened up the backstretch, lost the leading margin coming into upper stretch, had enough to fight on but was no match for the winner. SOMETHINTOBELIEVEN was prominent early inside but ceded the lead and switched out to stalk up the backstretch from off the inside, shifted to the rail entering the far turn advancing while saving ground, could not sustain the effort and flattened out late. BLAKELY'S BOY lacked early speed, saved ground and never threatened. UNIFIED USYK was off the leading pair moving in three to four wide on the first turn, stalked up the backstretch, continued three to four deep on the far turn and was asked for run by the quarter pole, faded in the stretch. HANG TUFF settled mid-pack off the inside early, switched out further off the inside up the backstretch, dropped back while coming into upper stretch six to seven wide, tired.

I BE GONE stalked from outside three to five wide moving closer to press the issue into and on the turn, kept on in the stretch, took the lead a sixteenth out and edged clear. LAST GASP broke sharply and was quickly clear, set the pace from off the rail, was hounded from outside by the eventual winner, overtaken by that one near the sixteenth pole but was second best. CRAZY DIXIE was forwardly-placed inside chasing the leading pair, dropped back a bit early on the turn, kept on and was clearly best of the rest. SONG OF VICTORY got away slowly, was well-back early, swung six wide and improved. DANCIN' MOLLY chased from outside mid-pack in the four to five path through the turn, came into upper stretch eight deep, failed to rally.
