MIDWEST WILDCAT bumped with an inner foe at the start, stalked in the three path, took command midway around the turn, was roused at the top of the lane, kept on while staying on his left lead, but was overtaken by an outer foe around the sixteenth. DON'TTAPHETILL bumped on both sides at the start, was wellback in the three path early, improved under a ride around the turn, floated out to the five path in upper stretch, and got up for show. PLAYGROUND WARRIOR pressed in the two path but weakened from the three path in the final furlong. LAST RETURN set the pace inside but yielded in the stretch. K J 'S RANSOM bumped with an outer foe at the start, then trailed throughout around the two to three paths.

BETHY stalked in the four path, was cued midway around the turn, took aim while swinging from the five path into the lane, stuck her head in front going by the furlong grounds, and drew clear. HIALEAH HOTTIE bumped with an outer foe at the start, laid up close in the two path, waited in the three path around the turn, was roused between foes in the four path at the top of the stretch, could not keep up with an outer foe in the final furlong, but kept on to edge place. MOON RIDGE bumped with an inner foe at the start, set the pace in the three path but faded in the final furlong. ROCK THE BIRDHOUSE chased in the three path, was driven along the inside around the turn, angled out to the six path while on the left lead passing the eighth pole, and finished evenly. DELTA LADY raced off the pace in the five path, floated out to the seven path turning into the stretch, and made no closing bid. LIFE OF SATURDAYS trailed in the four path, fanned out to the nine path at the top of the stretch, and did not threaten. MISS DUTTON had a slow start, was wellback along the inside early and never menaced.

BOGGALITA laid in range in the three path, took the lead under a nudge passing the three-eighths pole, and stayed on along the inside down the lane to hold sway. CHINATOWN GIRL stalked in the four path, bid midway around the far turn, headed the leader passing the quarter, floated out to the five path at the top of the stretch, and kept on but could not get past. STEAL PROUD rated in the five path, was driven in the four path around the far turn, and finished evenly on her left lead in the five path down the lane. DISTRACTED set the pace in the two path, lost the lead midway around the far turn, and yielded down the stretch. HOT N FRESH trailed in the five path and made no impact. LOOK MY WAY broke in and bumped an inner foe at the start, tracked inside but retreated around the far turn. SABRE ATTACK got fractious in the gate, hopped then stumbled while getting bumped by an outer foe at the start, was wellback in the three path, eased thru the stretch and walked off.

CARTHAGE CAJUN raced off the pace in the five path, ranged up to bid in the four path midway around the far turn, took command passing the quarter, and drew clear while drifting out in the final furlong. MAJOR CONTENDER set the pace inside, lost the lead just after the five-sixteenths pole, but dug in from the two path down the lane to hold place. TAPINYOURBLUEJEANS stalked in the four path, swung from the five path into the stretch, but flattened in the final sixteenth. BOLDISH trailed in the three path, swung from the five path into the stretch, got stymied around the sixteenth, but made no impact. DILLON ROCKS had a slow start, chased in the three path but weakened from the four path in the final furlong. SCOTCH NO ROCKS pressed in the two path but yielded around the far turn. ROAD GAME tracked inside but retreated after the half.

MEGAN'S HONOR laid up close along the inside, angled out to range up in the four path under a ride passing the quarter, bid while swinging from the seven path into the lane, took the lead passing the eighth pole, and stayed on to hold off a late charging outer foe. AMERICAN WARRIOR chased in the five path, fanned out to the eight path turning into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong, but was too late. SPYCRAFT tracked in the four path, bid in the three path midway around the turn, floated out to the six path at the top of the lane, and fought on before flattening in the final sixteenth. PHILIPSBURG (IRE) duelled for the lead in the two path, tipped out to the three path turning into the stretch, but yielded in the final furlong. CREPE YARNS trailed in the six path and made no impact from the four path down the lane. DUST DANCER vied for the lead in the three path but gave way on the left lead down the stretch.
