WHITELICK ROAD ran up behind horses on the backstretch and was steadied, settled off the pace inside, put in a steady effort and earned place while no threat to the winner. RATHER LATE pressed the pace, rallied between horses near the half mile pole, challenged for the lead on the turn, came up empty late and settled for show. LA ROSE BLANCHE broke in and bumped at the start, raced close to the pace towards the outside, dropped back entering the stretch and tired. TOUR DE' PORT bumped at the start to be last away, trailed the field and passed a tiring rival. MAYA'S WARRIOR got away well, pressed the pace to the turn and gave way.

MIDNIGHT'S GIRL was off a step slowly, raced inside to the turn, angled out, bid five wide, got a head in front near the eighth pole and inched clear late. DELTA LADY settled off the pace, bid inside on the turn, closed along the rail to contend, didn't have enough late and held for place. LONG TALL WOMAN lagged early, raced outside, bid six wide, closed steadily and earned show. I'M INTERESTED set a pressured pace, responded when challenged to duel to mid stretch and was unable to sustain her bid. FROSTED ECLAIR pressed the pace between horses, challenged for the lead on the turn, hung late and lost position. WILDWOOD ENCORE pressed the pace three wide, dropped back into the stretch and gave way.

LUTION was unhurried early, rallied around the turn, swung wide entering the stretch, closed with a rush, was in tight in the final strides and got up at the wire. RETAIL THERAPY was never far back, raced inside, bid along the rail on the turn, angled out for the drive, assumed command past the eighth pole, inched away, was steered out late and caught at the wire. 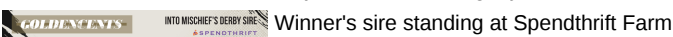

TURTLE PACE set the pace with a clear lead and held well in a driving finish. MISS DUQUOIN chased the pace, put in a steady bid, couldn't gain and finished second best. DERBY GALA was slow early, dropped inside, advanced along the rail on the turn, angled out in the upper stretch, found her best stride late and got up for show. KARAZEST dropped back into the turn, bid off the rail, failed to rally and was outfinished for third. MILAALAH raced in the second flight, rallied on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and leveled off. FANCY FEET was off a step slowly, was hustled along inside, saved ground, bid along the rail on the turn and came up empty. LAST CANDY lagged early, raced outside, advanced to the turn and had nothing left for the drive. MY TREASURE was not a factor. FROST BITTEN EARS was outrun. MISS FREEDOM was outrun and not urged late.
