HANG TUFF exchanged a bump at the start then was urged forward, tracked from inside, switched outside the leader near the quarter pole advancing on that one, bid nearing the furlong marker, edged clear. MY LAST ESCAPADE exchanged a bump at the start but was still quick to make the lead, set the pace just off the rail, was challenged in upper stretch, yielded grudgingly but was second best. LIES N DECEPTION was bumped at the start, altered inside a drifting foe early on the first turn, stalked three wide, kept on and was best of the rest. LORD BLOCK settled toward the back shifting in on the first turn, advanced inside up the backstretch and on the far turn saving ground, ran on inside in the lane but needed more. POSITION OUR LUCK floated out to the four or five path into the first turn racing between foes mid-division, shifted in a bit up the backstretch, went two to three wide on the far turn and asked by the quarter pole, ran on evenly. DANG IT BEAU settled last but one racing off the inside part of the track, went in the four to five path on the far turn encouraged along late on that bend, swung eight wide for the drive and ran on. MIDNIGHT MASTER raced inside foes but in the three path mid-division into the first turn, altered out midway up the backstretch racing very wide, shifted back in three deep dropping back entering the far turn, swung out nine wide, failed to make a bid. WILL CONQUER was caught five to six wide outside foes into the first turn, steadily advanced up early up the backstretch to within range of the leaders, dropped back and faded. I'M THISTY KID bumped a rival at the start, drifted out entering the first turn, straightened out and was up close stalking four wide, came up empty. K J 'S RANSOM lacked early speed and was outrun. DUE TO TIMER MALFUNCTION ONE MILE TIME WAS OMITTED PENDING REVIEW.

LUCKY DESTINY was carried six wide into the first turn shifting in a path, moved up heading up the backstretch stalking four then three wide, bid at the three-eighths dueling briefly, drew clear leaving the far turn and in upper stretch, held safe. MOVE IN SILENCE shifted in entering the first turn moving up inside to a narrow lead and forcing the pace up the backstretch, dropped back on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch, kept on to gain the place. BANDOLERO was moved out well off the inside heading into the first turn with the early lead, contended between foes up the backstretch, dueled inside the winner early on the far turn, faded in the lane. I GOT THE MOVES was carried seven wide through the first turn, shifted in up the backstretch dropping well off the leaders, passed tired rivals inside in the stretch. SNEAKY FEET moved out from five to six wide on the first turn, pursued from off the pace up the backstretch, continued four to five deep on the far turn under urging, came out for the drive, failed to rally. BEST DRESSED MAN was caught four wide into the first turn, pursued three wide up the backstretch mid-pack, failed to menace. GET ME ONE TOO trailed near the inside and made no impact. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

TUFF HEART prompted the pace from outside, took command leaving the turn, drew clear in upper stretch, drifted a bit but held well. RICHOCHET RICK lightly bumped the inside foe at the start, stalked the dueling leaders going three wide into the turn, came out five wide in range and looming a threat but could make no headway on the winner while saving the place. WILDWOOD ATTACK chased from between runners mid-pack, kept on inside but missed second. PREMOR was lightly bumped at the start, lacked early speed racing at the tail just off the inside, showed strong late effort to rally between foes but too late. MAJOR LEAGUE broke a bit awkwardly, moved up between foes in pursuit three wide into the turn, dropped back and shifted out, moved out further for the drive and passed some tired rivals. INCORPORATED chased from outside mid-pack going four to five wide on the turn, lacked a late kick. TAP THE PRIZE got away slowly, lacked early speed, raced four to five wide on the turn, swung ten wide into upper stretch, was never near enough to threaten. LAST CALL GENO chased from inside, dropped back late on the turn, came out for the stretch run, falied to menace. GHIDORAH set a pressured early pace inside the eventual winner just off the rail, faltered and faded.
