DUMB MONEY raced in the middle of the pack on the inside up the backstretch, came around the turn in the two path and finished evenly. I'M OTTER HERE raced off the pace on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the bend from the three path and never threatened. BOUNDFORTROUBLE bumped with the horse to his inside at the start, raced in the middle of the pack on the outside up the backstretch, began a bid from the four path coming around the turn and flattened out in the lane. EPITAPH trailed the field up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two path and made no bid.
