DREAM SCHEME got bumped by an inner foe at the start, stalked in the three path, was cued to bid early around the far turn, took command passing the quarter, dug in from the two path down the lane, drifted out in the final furlong, but held on. SPONGE TIME tracked inside, tipped out to the three path after the half, ranged up under coaxing passing the quarter, bid from the four path into the stretch, but got herded out by an inner foe in the final furlong, and could not get past. FLAG OFFICER was wellback in the three path, driven in the four path around the far turn, swung out to the six path at the top of the lane, and ran on for show. MILAZZO laid in midpack along the inside, was roused midway around the far turn, angled out to the five path at the top of the stretch, and finished evenly. DOGWOOD CROSSING rated in the four path, was roused in the five path midway around the far turn, fanned out to the seven path at the top of the lane, and mildly improved late. MALDINI raced off the pace inside, was ridden in the two path around the far turn, swung out to the five path turning into the stretch, but made no impact. WINEMAN TRAX broke out and bumped an outer foe, trailed in the four path, was cued in the three path midway around the far turn, but made no final bid along the inside down the lane. FLYING ASH set the pace inside, but lost the lead just before the quarter, and gaveway from the two path down the stretch. BLUE GOT IN chased in the two path but retreated, pulled up in the stretch, and walked off.
