THE FRANCHISE (IRE) was in a bit tight after the break, settled early, advanced in between rivals on the turn and waited for room leaving the quarter pole, found a seam leaving the furlong marker and split foes nearing the sixteenth marker and drew clear to prove best under a drive. WHISKEY PARK was well placed early on the inside, moved out entering the backstretch to be in the two path tracking the leaders, moved out to the three path midway on the far turn and made a four wide bid leaving the turn and gained a short lead in the furlong grounds but was out-kicked by the winner in a good effort. KATHEEB was off a step slow, settled three to two wide on the backstretch, then advanced three to four wide on the turn but was blocked leaving the quarter pole, moved in to follow the winner and finished well. BOURBON OUTLAW stalked the early pace three wide, made a two wide bid leaving the turn but faded in the final furlong. PET MAT was reserved early two wide, moved out to be on the outside on the backside, advanced four to five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the lane and had no late kick. WESTHAMPTON hit the gate coming out at the start, saved ground on the first turn while being reserved, moved out and

advanced four to five wide on the far turn, came seven wide into the lane and had a mild late kick. NANO MAN was four wide and in tight into the first turn and then checked and angled in, chased the pace from the inside and was ridden along by the three eighths marker to keep up but weakened in the lane. SUMMER STORM STRIC was settled back early and lacked a rally. KUWAIT TOWERS chased the early pace, three to four wide on the far turn and tired. TITAN set the pace while clear on the inside and was headed leaving the turn and gave way in the final furlong.

MR. BINKS stalked the pace on the outside, three to four wide on the turn, made a bid leaving the turn and was put to a long drive and got up late to prove best. SURF'S UP was off a half a step slow but quickly recovered and went up the inside to vie for command, dueled for the lead on the turn and gained a short lead off the bend, dug in and fought on gamely but could not hold off the winner while second best. FIRST NAVY JACK (IRE) vied for the early lead and then dueled for command two wide on the turn, between rivals off the bend and battled on before fading late while saving the show award. DEEP DUSK was off slowly, settled in the back and was three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the lane and had a late rally. OTTER MISCHIEF was reserved early, two path on the turn and came three wide into the lane, angled out in the drive and had a belated rally. GO WIN WON chased the pace three to four wide and came six wide into the lane and weakened. WHAT IT TIZ was reserved early on the inside, saved ground on the turn and had no rally. WAMPANOAG CHIEF chased the pace on the inside and weakened.

FOXTROT HARRY tracked the early pace on the inside and was shuffled back to last by the half mile marker, continued to save ground on the far turn, came two wide into the lane and angled out while advancing inside the furlong grounds and surged late to get up in time to prove best under a drive. BLAZE OF COLOR was four wide into the first turn, stalked the pace three wide and made a three wide bid leaving the turn to go on even terms, was put to a long drive and dueled for command but was denied on the wire. GUILDENSTERN (IRE) was reserved early, three to four wide on the far turn and came five wide into the lane to close well on the outside getting the bob for the show award.
