BOLD N BREEZY raced in the two path around the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack for the run up the backstretch, began a bid from the two path coming around the far turn and kicked clear. ALWAYS TRUE saved ground around the first turn, continued up the backstretch off the pace, swung out to the four path coming around the far turn and gained ground late. DOWN THE ISLANDS led the way on the inside through the opening half mile, continued to save ground around the far turn, dueled in upper stretch and gave way in the final furlong. BAROQUEN RECORD raced in the three path around the first turn, tracked the leader between horses up the backstretch, navigated the second turn still in the three path and faded in the lane. PREMIADO raced in the four path early, pressed the pace on the outside up the backstretch, dropped back while swinging out to the five path coming around the far turn and continued to tire from there. ENDRICK bumped with the horse to his inside at the start, recovered to duel on the outside up the backstretch, continued to battle from the three path around the turn and into the lane and gave way late, the best of the rest. AMBUSHED raced off the pace on the outside early, swung out to the five path coming around the bend, began a bid entering the stretch and improved position to the wire. BULLET BLUES stalked the leader on the outside through the opening quarter, navigated the turn from the four path and was outkicked in the lane. CRYPTO MAN tracked the leader on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the bend and weakened in the stretch. TIZ THE COAST bumped with the horse to his outside at the break, raced in the middle of the pack through the early going, continued around the turn in the three path and faded from there. FIGHT TIL DAWN raced at the back of the pack through the opening stages, navigated the bend from the two path and showed no kick. CAJUN FOOL raced off the pace on the inside up the backstretch, came around the turn in the two path and made no bid. ROMERO trailed the field up the backstretch, continued around the bend in the four path and was never a threat. GRAND AVILA was pinched back leaving the gate, rushed up to race in the middle of the pack on the inside up what remained of the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and tired in the lane.

BACK IN THE SADDLE saved ground around the first turn, tracked the leader on the inside up the backstretch, continued around the far turn in the three path, began a bid passing the quarter pole and drew off to the finish. INTERIM ANALYSIS raced in the two path headed into the first turn, drifted in and bumped with WORTH THE WAIT in the process, settled in the middle of the pack on the inside for the run up the backstretch, saved ground around the second bend, began a bid entering the stretch and gained ground late but was no match for the winner. SIGAN VIENDO raced in the two path early, led the way up the backstretch, dueled around the far bend while still in the two path, could not go with the winner in the stretch and kept on from there. DREAMBUILDER chased the leader on the inside through the opening half mile, continued to save ground around the far turn and was outkicked in the

stretch. DRACULA raced in the three path around the first turn, continued up the backstretch in the middle of the pack on the outside, navigated the far turn from the two path and finished evenly. SPONGE TIME saved ground early, trailed the field up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the second turn and made up some ground in the lane while never threatening. POWER FROM ABOVE raced in the two path around the first turn, settled off the pace on the inside for the run up the backstretch, came around the far turn still in the two path and made no bid. JOHNNY NOTIME stalked the leader from the three path through the opening half mile, challenged headed into the far turn, raced in the two path from there and tired in the lane. WORTH THE WAIT raced into traffic on the rail when INTERIM ANALYSIS came into his lane, bumping with that rival and stumbling over his heels, took out to the three path to find racing room from there, raced off the pace on the outside up the backstretch, saved ground around the far bend and was empty in the stretch.
