SIMO close up to the early pace, tracked four then three wide into the turn, took command at the top of the lane, drew off into the final sixteenth, kept to task late under mild hand urging. SWINGING SOLO rated just off of the early pace, saved ground to the turn, caught in tight and bumped midway along the bend, battled from the inside into upper stretch, no match for the winner into the drive, held for a share of the place honors. SONG SO SWEET sent to contest the early pace from between foes, traded bumps with SWINGING SOLO midway through the turn, got outkicked by the eventual winner into upper stretch, fought on through the lane and got up in time to share for the place honors. WASAMATTAFOYOU away in good order, contested the early pace between foes, stalked three wide into the turn then was shuffled back approaching the quarter pole, fought on into the stretch, needed more late and was outkicked for the place honors. FIGHTING WORDS settled outside of rivals, widest nearing the quarter pole, spun five wide to the stretch and passed tiring rivals late. FRIOLENTO settled just off of the early pace, lacked the needed response nearing the quarter marker, trailed into upper stretch and did not rally late. DIME PAPI close up to the early pace while four then five wide approaching the turn, tracked to the quarter marker, lost ground into upper stretch and weakened in the drive.

TIMSHEL attended to the decent pace into the backstretch, vied between rivals into the far turn then battled into the stretch, determinedly dug in into the final sixteenth and held off the runner-up in deep stretch to prevail. I'M SAM well placed early on, stalked the pace three wide to the half-mile, bid into the far turn and took a narrow lead at the quarter marker, battled outside of a pair rivals into the lane, lost the lead to TIMSHEL in the final sixteenth, was denied for the win in deep stretch and held clearly for the place. JUSTIN SMILES settled off of the early pace, never far back along the backstretch, chased from the three then four path into upper stretch, mounted a mild late rally, could not impact the top pair late and was along for the show. TIMEFRAME showed good speed away from the gate, took early command and set a contested pace to the backstretch, came under pressure and met oncoming bids into the far turn, battled into upper stretch, could not find more into the final furlong and faded late.

MULLY'S MOON settled in the early going, shifted out and raced outside of rivals heading to the turn, roused two then three wide nearing the quarter marker, swung to the four path to upper stretch, full of run in the lane, took command nearing the sixteenth-marker and drew away in deep stretch. AWEGOD hard to load prior to the start, contested the early pace from outside of IRON THE MONEY then took back approaching the turn, re-rallied two wide nearing the quarter marker, took command and led into the final furlong, no match late for the winner, bested the rest. DOMINICAN PIRATE was crowded a bit at the start and off a step slowly, unhurried in the early stages, advanced two wide and between foes nearing the quarter marker, continued that bid to mid-stretch, could not impact the top pair late but held well for third. ACTION DELIGHT rated off of the early pace and tracked the leading pair along the backstretch, saved ground into the turn then tipped out into upper stretch, chased between rivals into the final furlong, weakened in the final sixteenth. UNCLE ZEB bobbled a bit leaving the start, settled off of the early pace, coaxed four wide to the quarter marker, was widest to upper stretch and did not rally late. GIGLINE settled off of the early pace, saved ground into the turn, shifted out at the quarter marker then trailed into upper stretch, kept on into the lane but could not find the needed late response. IRON THE MONEY hustled away from the gate, contested the early pace with AWEGOD then shook free into the turn, made his own pace along the bend then came under pressure nearing the quarter, overtaken into upper stretch, tired in the final furlong.

FROSTY BELLE broke in at the start and was off a bit slowly, rushed up along the inside and was well placed approaching the turn, angled to the three path at the quarter marker, loomed at the three-sixteenths then quickly took command into the stretch, kicked clear at the furlong marker then drew off into the final sixteenth, was ridden out to the wire and won as much the best. MISS MAGICAL settled and saved ground in the early running, advanced along the inside nearing the quarter marker, angled four wide to upper stretch, closed willingly into the final sixteenth, was no match late for the winner but was a clear second best. BOOMBOX BETTY broke out a bit at the start, was prominent early, rated off of the pace then was caught a bit in tight between rivals along the backstretch, tracked the pace two to three wide into the turn, ran in pursuit to mid-stretch, was outkicked for second and held safely in the end for third. PRACTICALLY FAMOUS crowded a bit at the start by an inner rival, settled off of the early pace then went up to press the pace two to three wide into the turn, disputed the moderate pace into the bend then vied for the lead at the quarter marker, got outkicked by the winner to upper stretch, yielded in the drive and was outfinished for the minor awards. LITTLE TOWN STREET hustled away from the start, took early command then set the pace from the two path heading into the turn, shifted closer to the rail into the bend and met oncoming bids nearing the quarter marker, could not keep pace with the winner to upper stretch, gave way in the final sixteenth. BIG LOUS MESSENGER off a step slowly, allowed to settle in the early stages, caught four wide into the turn, lacked the needed response to upper stretch, no factor late. CASSADAGA close up to the early pace while between foes, chased to the turn then dropped back into the bend, trailed nearing the quarter marker, was eased through the stretch and walked off.

COFFEE AT K J'S rated off early pace, well placed to the turn, angled four wide nearing the top of the lane, vied to mid-stretch, battled to the final sixteenth then shook free late, proved best. ZEVI'S ZONE settled to the turn, waited behind runners nearing the top of the lane, found room into the stretch then closed well into the final sixteenth, could not reel in the winner late, up for second. SABIAN showed good early speed, disputed the pace three wide to the turn, poked a head in front turning for home, met the bid of COFFEE AT K J'S to mid-stretch, stubbornly battled to the final sixteenth, turned away late by the winner, was outkicked for second and well clear of the rest for third. CAJUN GOLD showed good early speed, disputed the quick pace from the inside heading to the turn, vied to the quarter marker then dug in and battled to upper stretch, lost position at the furlong grounds, faded in the final stages. FEAR bobbed at the start and was last away from the gate, recovered and settled in the second flight on the run to the turn, advanced three then four wide nearing the quarter marker, swung five wide to upper stretch, lacked the needed response to the furlong grounds and weakened late. NIGHT prominent early, disputed the pace two wide and between foes heading to the turn, pressed the solid pace to the quarter marker, got caught a bit in tight nearing the top of the lane, lost ground nearing the furlong pole and gave way in the final stages. CAMIGOL settled off of the early pace then crowded a bit approaching the turn, trailed to the quarter marker and did not factor in the stretch drive.
