MISS OCALA settled at the back inside, bided time up the backstretch, moved out will beginning to advance on the far turn, fanned six wide coming to the top of the stretch, paused briefly in mid-stretch in behind runners, made a bold move between runners soon after to just get up in the shadow of the wire. MARABINA was a bit hard to control in the early going racing off the inside in the three to four path into and on the first turn, moved nearer the rail heading up the backstretch tracking in behind and off the leading pair, moved three to four wide on the far turn, bid between runners coming past the quarter pole, drifted out about seven wide coming into upper stretch then drifted back in regaining a narrow lead, appeared to wait in the late stages and was caught. NOT ONE LESS settled at the rear early while kept well off the rail racing three to five wide, shifted in leaving the first turn still racing well back up the backstretch, moved out on the far turn beginning to advance, fanned seven wide racing outside the eventual winner, kept on between runners late but needed more. SAINTE CHAPELLE tucked in early settling in behind the leaders tracking while saving ground, moved out about midway on the far turn given mild encouragement, lacked room in behind and between briefly coming past the quarter pole, had clear sailing soon after, kept on evenly and was best of the rest. IN OTHER WORDS had forward position stalking from outside three to four wide, was in a bit tight past the quarter pole and altered out a path at that juncture, lacked the needed late kick. MY HAPPY HOLIDAY stalked in behind and outside a foe two to three wide, dropped back on the far turn, failed to make a bid. SILJIM set a pressured pace inside foes but off the fence, faltered and faded.

OLIVIA VALENTINA was lightly bumped at the start, shifted in and unhurriedly brought up the rear saving ground, continued to ride the rail on the far turn into upper stretch, advanced inside foes, came out with aim on the runner-up, rallied but fell short while securing show honors. CROSS HASTE was quick to the lead and clear, set the pace inside but off the fence, began lugging out near the furlong marker under left-handed urging and continued to do so till late stretch, straightened out and dug in and just held. MAYHEMINTHEPALACE settled in behind tracking inside, saved ground on the turn, angled five wide at the top of the stretch, attempted to split rivals, was put in tight quarters by the drifting leader, altered course inside that one past the furlong marker, continued to fight on but missed. SOLOMONS GOLD broke just a step slowly, moved up outside heading to the turn racing about five to six deep, advanced leaving that bend and in upper stretch, was forced out a bit near the sixteenth pole, kept on but needed more. GOLDEN SKULL switched out early, was kept wide while trailing, was five to six wide coming to the quarter pole, floated wider still to be nine deep in upper stretch, finished well but too late. MADNESS pressed the winner from outside two to three wide, weakened in the stretch. AMOR LEJANO (ARG) raced off the pace removed from the rail, came out eight to nine deep in the stretch, made no impact. ROLLING ON chased the leading pair, was under strong urging passing the three-eighths racing four to five wide and within range coming to the top of the stretch, faltered and faded. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AS WELL AS AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF MAYHEMINTHEPALACE AGAINST CROSS HASTE ALLEGING INTERFERENCE, THE LATTER WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST AND PLACED SECOND BEHIND THE FORMER.

SUGAR BUZZ was forwardly-placed four to five wide outside runners in the second flight into and on the first turn, moved a bit nearer inside stalking up the backstretch, entered the far turn two to three deep in behind the leaders, angled to the rail at the quarter pole cutting the corner into upper stretch, made a rail bid at the top of the stretch, held foes at bay and prevailed. SON OF A SLEW settled inside the second flight early, bided time saving ground through the far turn, got through inside rivals in upper stretch, tipped out past the furlong marker for room and with aim on the leaders, gained steadily but missed. STEELIN BASES was forwardly positioned two to three wide between runners into the first turn, stalked the leader in behind shifting in to race near the rail for the run up the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn advancing in a rail bid taking a narrow lead at the quarter pole, drifted out leaving the turn and was overtaken by an inside rival, kept on strongly outside that foe but was outfinished and lost place late. SENTENZA settled off the pace near the inside, saved some ground through both turns, angled seven to eight wide at the top of the stretch, kicked on mildly and just rounded out the super. BANDOOLA shifted in saving ground on the first turn at the back, moved out a bit to advance past foes outside on the far turn fanning eleven wide into upper stretch, finished strongly to be gaining widest of all but was too late. LEGAL MANEUVER was unhurried racing toward the back off the rail early, moved out on the far turn coming into upper stretch swinging nine wide, ran on. GREY SHADOW settled between runners two to three wide mid-pack in the second flight on the first turn, moved out and advanced outside foes up the backstretch came to the guarter pole under urging and within striking distance but could not sustain the effort. MR BRIZEL was prominent early inside, moved clear early on the first turn, set the pace from off the rail, was challenged by foes inside and out late on the far turn, gave way. AMERICAN WIND was well-placed moving forward outside three to four wide stalking into the first turn, edged closer outside on the far turn making a brief bid nearing the quarter pole, faltered and faded. PAXTON settled early then had to alter outside a foe two to three wide heading into the first turn, moved out further to be six wide for the run up the backstretch, shifted in a bit advancing mildly four wide on the far turn, faltered and faded thereafter. STRENGTHNGUIDANCE was unhurried early while lacking speed racing outside foes at the back three to four wide, shifted in, was not a factor.
