HOPE WITH POPE tracked the pace three wide nearing the quarter marker then was floated five wide into upper stretch, battled ADIOS TIPSY to the final sixteenth, turned away that rival into deep stretch and drew clear late. ADIOS TIPSY close up in the early stages, tracked the pace two wide into the turn, floated four wide into upper stretch, battled HOPE WITH POPE to the final sixteenth, could not keep pace with the winner late and bested the rest. ALWAYS DRAMA contested the early pace then stalked into the turn, chased two wide nearing the quarter marker then drifted to the three path into upper stretch, was no match for the top pair late and held safely in the end for third. SPLASH DIVE settled in the second flight to begin, saved ground to the stretch then bid nearing the furlong marker, could not sustain that run into the late stages and lacked a final response. TOKU bumped at the start and off slowly, ran in pursuit four wide into upper stretch and passed tiring rivals in the final furlong to improve position. TRISH allowed to settle early, chased two to three wide to upper stretch and did not threaten late. MISSCOLTFORTYFIVE contested the early pace then took command into the turn, set decent fractions nearing the quarter marker, was weary into the lane then was overtaken at the furlong grounds and stopped in the stretch drive. MI GITANITA broke well then took back in the early going, trailed to the quarter pole and did not make a late impact. ONEMORSILVERDOLLAR off slowly, raced five wide to upper stretch and did

not factor. COSMIC SYMPHONY bumped with TOKU leaving the break, settled while saving ground into the turn, lacked a response leaving the quarter pole and tired in the drive.

BOOT'S ON THE MOON allowed to settle early on while never far back, roused five wide into upper stretch, closed determinedly into the final furlong, surged to take command in deep stretch and held for the win at the finish. HONOR HER well placed in the early going, tracked three wide to the turn and loomed four wide into upper stretch, vied for the lead at the furlong pole then took command past mid-stretch, clung to a narrow lead into the final sixteenth and was bested by the winner in deep stretch while holding clearly for second. WHITE CLAW WOMAN (IRE) squeezed at the start, recovered and tracked the pace while saving ground to the turn, maintained a rail trip to upper stretch, was outkicked into the final sixteenth and held well late for third. OUR LADY PEACE tracked the early pace two wide and between runners heading to the turn, chased three wide and between rivals to upper stretch, was caught in tight then checked nearing the furlong grounds, ran in pursuit to the final sixteenth and just missed for the show honors. LONG GONE SALLY broke out and bothered a neighboring rival, assumed early command then showed the way to the turn, set the pace from the two path into upper stretch, was overtaken into the final furlong then gave way. CUE THE MUSIC caught a bit in tight at the start and off a step slowly, settled while saving ground in the early stages, chased two wide to upper stretch, angled out at the furlong marker then weakened. FUSSY GIRL settled between rivals in the early stages, was caught a bit in tight into the turn then was shuffled back midway through the turn, trailed into the stretch and could not muster a final response. THERE WAS A JOCKEY'S OBJECTION LODGED BY THE RIDER OF OUR LADY PEACE AGAINST THE RIDER OF HONOR HER FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH RUN. THE STEWARDS DISALLOWED THAT OBJECTION AND RULED NO CHANGE.

IFYOUSAIDSO broke alertly, showed good early speed and sprinted to a clear lead heading to the turn, shook free from pursuers into upper stretch, drew off at the furlong grounds then was ridden out in the final sixteenth and won as much the best. ARMY MEDIC chased the pace two to three wide and from between runners, was no match for the winner into the final furlong and held well late for the place honors. BIRCH RUN lunged at the start and was off slowly, ran in pursuit four to five wide to upper stretch then was green through the lane, could not find the needed late response and just missed for second, while getting up in time for third. STREET BELLE raced close up to the early pace, chased three to four wide nearing the quarter marker, shifted in into upper stretch, could not muster a final late response and was outfinished for the minor awards. ZERO REMORSE tracked the pace from the inside then weakened in the stretch. HOLY SPICY lacked early speed and trailed throughout.

GOES THE CLOWN well placed in the early stages, tracked the decent pace while saving ground into the backstretch, tipped out at the quarter marker and bid two wide into upper stretch, took command at the furlong pole then held off the runner-up in deep stretch. DISATTACHED allowed to settle while never far back, got caught a bit in tight into the first turn then recovered and tracked the pace two to three wide up the backstretch, chased to the quarter marker then rallied three wide for the stretch drive, was gaining in the late stages but could not reel in the winner late and was a clear second. SARATOGA CRUISER unhurried in the early stages, was roused four wide into upper stretch, could not impact the leading pair late but was able to close the gap in the final sixteenth and was clear in the end for third. DIME PAPI a step slow leaving the start, settled into the first turn, made a three to four wide middle move to vie for the lead at the half-mile pole, dueled ADVENTUROUS SPIRIT into the second turn, shook free of that rival in upper stretch then was overtaken at the furlong grounds, gave way in the late stages and was outfinished for the show honors. GREAT SHASHI was prominent early on, stalked the moderate pace up the backstretch then vied for the lead into the second turn, took command into upper stretch and was set down for the drive, dug in while under pressure into the final furlong, held off PASAJERA into the final sixteenth and kept to task in the late stages for a determined win. PASAJERA settled four wide into the first turn, stalked outside of rivals along the backstretch run, loomed three wide nearing the quarter marker, rallied and vied for the lead into the final furlong, was kept at bay into deep stretch and held safely at the wire for second. NANANANABOOBOO settled in the second flight and between runners, advanced along the backstretch then chased two wide and between foes nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit from the rail into the final furlong, was outkicked in deep stretch and held well late for third. BOMB SQUAD settled three

wide in the early stages, chased two wide into the far turn, raced in traffic into upper stretch then found room into the final furlong, mounted a mild late rally and just missed for third. HITS DIFFERENT allowed to settle into the first turn, advanced while widest up the backstretch, chased four wide to the quarter marker, ran in pursuit five wide into the lane, could not sustain her run into the final sixteenth and flattened out late. R AWESOME SAUCE well placed while saving ground in the early stages, tracked from the rail heading to the second turn, lacked a response when called upon into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. GOOD BRIGHT FLAMES sent to assume early command, set a moderate pace to the half-mile marker then came under pressure heading to the second turn, dueled GREAT SHASHI to the quarter pole, could not keep pace into upper stretch then faded in the final furlong. MAMUKA lacked early speed, trailed to the second turn then did not factor in the stretch drive.
