GAME CHANGER JOLIE, along the inner rail on the turn, swung four wide leaving the bend and flattened out. MAKE SENSE OF IT showed speed between horses down the backstretch and faded on the turn. VENEZUELAN PRIDE disputed the early pace between horses and weakened on the turn. DONE DIRT CHEAP, a forward factor between horses on the backstretch, gave way and drifted very wide turning for home. A FANCY SOLUTION showed speed between horses and faltered.
