STARSHIP MAGELLAN well placed in the early stages, tracked the decent pace three wide to the half-mile pole, asked for run four wide along the far turn, rallied to upper stretch then vied for the lead at the furlong grounds, responded and took command into the final sixteenth and held for the win over the oncoming runner-up. ANIMATED allowed to settle while never far back, raced between foes and two wide to the far turn, was bottled up and in traffic to upper stretch, blocked past mid-stretch then found an opening into the final sixteenth, rallied between foes into deep stretch and came up just short for the win, while getting up in time for the place. LILYS BACK rated just off of the early pace, tracked two then three wide to the far turn, bid to upper stretch then vied between foes into the final furlong, was outfinished in deep stretch for the win and place and was clear for the show. BIG BOB prominent away from the start, attended to the early pace then took command into the backstretch, showed the way to the far turn, met oncoming bids into the lane, battled past mid-stretch and yielded in the final sixteenth. DISTINGUISHED GENT sent to contest the early pace, led into the first turn then ceded the front into the backstretch, stalked to the far turn then vied for the lead between rivals into the stretch, battled past the furlong marker and faded in the final sixteenth. SECRET POWER was a bit keen while tracking the early pace from the inside, was well placed to the second turn, lacked racing room to upper stretch, steadied on heels approaching the final sixteenth and could not find a final response. JIMBO BAILEY allowed to settle, raced widest up the backstretch, trailed to the far turn and did not factor in the late stages.

GAME IT forwardly placed early on, tracked the pace two then three wide along the turn, loomed past the quarter marker then took command inside of the furlong pole, kept to task into the final sixteenth and held well late for the win. SERENITY PATH settled in the second flight, advanced three wide nearing the quarter marker, spun four wide for the stretch drive, closed well into the final furlong, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch and held late for second. CASH THE CHECK off a step slow to begin, advanced four then five wide approaching the top of the stretch, finished well into the final sixteenth and was along for third. TURKISH FLAME allowed to settle early, advanced two to three wide nearing the top of the lane, closed willingly into the final sixteenth but could not reel in the top three late. BELLA'S BREEZE sent for the early lead, showed good speed and sprinted clear into the turn, led to upper stretch, was overtaken into the final furlong and faded in the final sixteenth. GRAND THREAT settled mid-pack, chased three wide to the stretch and could not muster a late response. ATOMIC FLEA was bumped soon after the start and away a bit slowly, lacked early speed, advanced six wide nearing the quarter marker, could not sustain that run to the stretch and weakened late. MEARA'S WISH lost his path at the start and was off slowly, recovered and chased the early pace from the inside, saved ground to the stretch then could not threaten in the late stages. GRENACHE veered out at the start and was off slowly, lacked early speed, was coaxed three wide to the stretch and did not factor late. MONEY RULES chased the early pace from the inside, could not keep pace nearing the quarter marker, stopped into upper stretch and came up empty in the drive. THE TRAINER OF SERENITY PATH LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF GAME IT, CLAIMING INTERFERENCE IN UPPER STRETCH. THE STEWARDS DISALLOWED THAT

OBJECTION AND RULED THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.

PRINCE DAVID unhurried in the early going, roused four to five wide to upper stretch, responded in the lane then closed fast into the final sixteenth and got up for the win in the final strides. GRAND JOKER hustled away from the start, dueled for pace duties along the inside, shook free into upper stretch then kicked clear past the furlong marker, maintained a clear lead into the final sixteenth, was nailed for the win in the final strides and held for second at the finish. 

BERT'S KNOTY GIRL was prominent in the early going, stalked the modest pace up the backstretch then vied for the lead into the far turn, dueled on even terms with TIADORO into the stretch, took command into the final furlong and dug in when confronted by SPICY PRINCESS, determinedly held the runner-up at bay into the final sixteenth and lasted for the win. SPICY PRINCESS well placed in the early stages, tracked the pace from the inside up the backstretch, saved ground to the far turn then tipped three wide for the stretch drive, rallied into the final furlong, could not get by the determined winner in deep stretch and was well clear of the rest for second. BIRCH RUN off a bit slowly leaving the start, settled three wide into the first turn, raced widest up the backstretch then mounted a three wide bid into the far turn, chased the leaders to the furlong grounds, was outkicked in the final sixteenth but stayed on well in deep stretch and got up in time for third. TIADORO broke alertly and assumed early command, set a modest pace to the backstretch, met the bid of BERT'S KNOTY GIRL at the quarter marker, battled to mid-stretch then weakened in the late stages and just missed for third. AFFIRMING lost her path at the start and was off a step slowly, settled off of the early pace, asked for run three wide nearing the quarter marker, angled out into upper stretch, made a

mild rally to the final sixteenth but needed more late. IMPERIA BLUE settled off of the early pace, saved ground to the second turn then waited for racing room nearing the quarter marker, angled out for the stretch drive and offered a mild late rally. MISCHIEVOUS SCOUT raced on a snug early hold while forwardly placed into the first turn, tracked the modest pace three wide to the half-mile marker, chased between rivals into the far turn, could not keep pace to mid-stretch then gave way in the final stages. WELCOME SURPRISE settled in the second flight leaving the start, was floated out along the first turn then tucked in between rivals into the backstretch, chased from the two path then from the rail nearing the quarter pole, ran evenly to the furlong marker and did not offer a late response. IVEY MY LOVE in tight while keen into the first turn, checked into that bend then lost position into the backstretch, trailed to the half-mile marker then did not factor in the late stages.
