

PET MAT tracked the early pace from the inside, was well placed into the turn, mounted a rail bid to upper stretch, confronted MAJOR KING nearing the furlong marker then dueled to the final sixteenth, took a narrow lead in deep stretch and held late for a determined win. MAJOR KING vied for the early lead, contested the pace from the inside heading into the turn, led to upper stretch, dug in and met the bid of PET MAT at the furlong pole, dueled to the final sixteenth, was gamely bested in deep stretch and was clear of the rest for second. BLUE SLIDE PARK settled off of the early pace, roused five wide to the stretch, could not reel in the top pair late and was clear in the end for third. LUNI SIMA raced close up to the early pace, stalked three to four wide nearing the quarter pole, could not keep pace into the final furlong and weakened in the late stages. SPEIGHT'SPERCOMETE was prominent away from the start, pressed the pace two wide and between foes into the turn, was repelled into upper stretch then gave way in the final furlong. KIKILOVE threw her head at the break and was off slowly, unhurried in the early stages, was coaxed two wide to the stretch and did not factor in the drive. RARE JEWEL allowed to settle early on while never far back, lost position four wide into the turn and then came up empty in the stretch drive. BIRD WILDCAT was forwardly placed in the early stages, dropped back along the backstretch, trailed into the turn, was eased through the stretch and walked off.

BERT'S KNOTY GIRL was prominent in the early going, stalked the modest pace up the backstretch then vied for the lead into the far turn, dueled on even terms with TIADORO into the stretch, took command into the final furlong and dug in when confronted by SPICY PRINCESS, determinedly held the runner-up at bay into the final sixteenth and lasted for the win. SPICY PRINCESS well placed in the early stages, tracked the pace from the inside up the backstretch, saved ground to the far turn then tipped three wide for the stretch drive, rallied into the final furlong, could not get by the determined winner in deep stretch and was well clear of the rest for second. BIRCH RUN off a bit slowly leaving the start, settled three wide into the first turn, raced widest up the backstretch then mounted a three wide bid into the far turn, chased the leaders to the furlong grounds, was outkicked in the final sixteenth but stayed on well in deep stretch and got up in time for third. TIADORO broke alertly and assumed early command, set a modest pace to the backstretch, met the bid of BERT'S KNOTY GIRL at the quarter marker, battled to mid-stretch then weakened in the late stages and just missed for third. AFFIRMING lost her path at the start and was off a step slowly, settled off of the early pace, asked for run three wide nearing the quarter marker, angled out into upper stretch, made a

mild rally to the final sixteenth but needed more late. IMPERIA BLUE settled off of the early pace, saved ground to the second turn then waited for racing room nearing the quarter marker, angled out for the stretch drive and offered a mild late rally. WELCOME SURPRISE settled in the second flight leaving the start, was floated out along the first turn then tucked in between rivals into the backstretch, chased from the two path then from the rail nearing the quarter pole, ran evenly to the furlong marker and did not offer a late response. IVEY MY LOVE in tight while keen into the first turn, checked into that bend then lost position into the backstretch, trailed to the half-mile marker then did not factor in the late stages.
