SAMARITAN'S JOY broke alertly and was prominent away from the start, ceded the early lead and stalked the pace two wide to the turn, tracked BELLA'S BREEZE to the quarter marker then was roused to upper stretch, made a strong bid into the final furlong, overtook BELLA'S BREEZE into the final sixteenth and drew off while in hand in deep stretch. BELLA'S BREEZE sent to be prominent early, took command in the opening furlong and set the pace to the turn, carved out a decent pace to the quarter marker then held a clear lead to upper stretch, was overtaken by the winner past mid-stretch, could not keep pace with SAMARITAN'S JOY into the final sixteenth and stayed on well late to be second best. GOLDIE GLORY tracked the early pace from between rivals, chased two wide to the quarter marker, drifted out past the quarter pole and ran in pursuit three deep into upper stretch, was not able to make headway on the top pair late but stayed on to be a clear third. JUNEGENAI was well placed between rivals in the early going, raced greenly to the turn then trailed nearing the quarter marker, coaxed two wide to upper stretch, could not impact the leaders late and passed tiring rivals in the drive. GRENACHE settled between rivals in the early stages, ran in pursuit three wide heading to the quarter marker, got floated out and caught a bit in tight nearing the top of the lane, lacked the needed response to mid-stretch and did not rally late. JUST MAJESTIC chased the early pace from inside, ran in pursuit while saving ground into the turn, lost position nearing the quarter marker and did not threaten in the stretch drive. TOASTTOSTHESTONES got crowded at the start and was off slowly, recovered and chased the pace from outside of rivals heading into the turn, ran in pursuit four to five wide nearing the quarter marker, could not find more into the stretch drive and weakened. BY MY DREAMS tracked the early pace from outside of rivals, ran in pursuit three wide into the turn, got caught a bit in tight between rivals nearing the top of the lane, could not keep pace to mid-stretch and tired in the final stages.

WILL OF A WARRIOR settled in the early stages while never far back, tracked the moderate pace heading to the half-mile marker, coaxed three to four wide to the quarter marker then set down into upper stretch, confronted IL ALCHEMYSTA into the final furlong, wore down the game runner-up in deep stretch and won the nod on the wire to prevail. IL ALCHEMYSTA raced between rivals in the early stages then took back into the first turn, advanced while widest along the backstretch, loomed three wide into the far turn then took command to upper stretch, dug in into the final furlong and met the bid of WILL OF A WARRIOR to the final sixteenth, fought gamely to the wire and just missed for the win, while besting the rest. CRYPTONYM got squeezed a bit at the start and was allowed to settle in the early stages, was unhurried to the half-mile marker, roused outside of rivals into the far turn then rallied five to six wide to upper stretch, closed well into the final furlong, could not make headway on the top pair late and was clear for third. LAST RUN was prominent away from the start, raced close up to the early pace while saving ground into the first turn, tracked from the inside along the backstretch, ran in pursuit from the rail heading to the quarter pole, angled out to upper stretch then lacked the needed response in the final sixteenth. KUWAIT TOWERS vied for early command from between rivals, took the lead into the backstretch then set a moderate pace while prompted into the far turn, met oncoming bids heading to the quarter marker, was overtaken to upper stretch and faded in the final stages. MORAL AGENCY settled just off of the early pace and outside of rivals heading into the first turn, tracked the moderate pace three to four wide along the backstretch, gave chase to the quarter pole then spun five wide to upper stretch, could not find more at the furlong grounds and weakened. PROUD AMERICAN was forwardly placed while three wide to the first turn, went up and prompted the moderate pace along the backstretch, vied for the lead between rivals into the far turn, was outkicked to upper stretch then tired in the final furlong. SPONGE TIME close up in the early going, raced a bit in tight while inside of rivals then between foes into the first turn, tracked two to three wide and between runners along the backstretch, got shuffled back into the far turn then ran in pursuit to the quarter marker, trailed to upper stretch and gave way in the drive.

SWEET LAZARUS veered out at the start and made contact with ARAUCANO leaving the break, took early command and set a decent pace along the backstretch, was pressured from the inside heading into the turn by FINAL PAYMENT, shook free of that rival and dictated terms to the quarter pole, drifted out to upper stretch then held off foes nearing the furlong grounds, kept to task to the final sixteenth and held safely late for the win. EXPERT WITNESS settled just off of the early pace and tracked along the backstretch, angled out along the turn, ran in pursuit from the five to six path to upper stretch, closed willingly into the final furlong, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch and held late for the place honors. FINAL PAYMENT raced close up to the early pace, stalked from the inside along the backstretch then went up to press SWEET LAZARUS heading into the turn, was turned away into the bend then re-bid between rivals nearing the top of the lane, stubbornly battled into the final furlong, was outkicked in the final sixteenth and was well clear of the rest for third. TEMPERATURE RISING settled off of the early pace, coaxed three wide to upper stretch, needed more in the late stages and finished evenly. ARAUCANO got bumped at the start but was away in good order, raced close up to the early pace and tracked three deep heading to the half-mile marker, chased to the quarter pole, got floated out nearing the top of the lane then angled in to upper stretch, could not find more at the furlong grounds and weakened. UFO (PER) lost his path at the start and was off slowly, was allowed to settle and saved ground into the turn, angled out to upper stretch and was able to improve position in the drive but did not threaten the leaders late. BONFIGLIO was unhurried in the early going, ran in pursuit from the rail then from the two path nearing the quarter pole, lacked the needed response to upper stretch and did not factor late. LAO WAY allowed to settle early, raced

outside of rivals heading into the turn, coaxed four wide to upper stretch and did not make a late impact.

POP ROX ceded the early lead, stalked three wide to the turn then went up and pressed outside of SLEW DIVA heading to the quarter marker, bid from the three path to upper stretch, took command into the final furlong then drove clear past mid-stretch and was kept to task in the final sixteenth. FULLY ENTITLED tracked the early pace from outside of rivals, was well placed while three to four wide nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit of POP ROX into the stretch, could not match strides with the winner into the final sixteenth and outfinished the rest for the place honors. CARROLL'S HONOR raced close up to the early pace, tracked from the inside heading into the turn, chased to the quarter marker then tipped out to upper stretch, ran in pursuit of POP ROX into the final furlong, was outkicked in the final sixteenth and was clear of the rest for third. SLEW DIVA broke alertly and assumed early command, set the pace to the turn then was pressured by POP ROX heading to the quarter marker, overtaken to upper stretch, fought on into the final furlong and gave way late. GEAUX AMY got shuffled a bit leaving the start and was off a step slowly, settled off of the early pace and trailed heading into the turn, was roused two wide to the quarter marker and did not factor in the stretch drive. GRACE THE LAW settled off of the early pace while never far back, chased between rivals into the turn, lost action at the three-eighths marker, was pulled up at the five-sixteenths pole and was euthanized on the track.
