MARANTA contested the early pace from inside of rivals, pressed into the turn then took command nearing the quarter marker, drew clear while a bit erratic into the stretch, kept to task late under steady urging and drew away in deep stretch. MONEY BATTLE was well placed in the early stages, tracked the pace from the inside heading into the turn, tipped out two wide for the stretch drive, chased MARANTA to mid-stretch, could not make headway on the winner late and was second best. DANCE TO REMEMBER settled away from the start, saved ground to the turn then made a steady gain approaching the quarter marker, ran in pursuit from the inside into upper stretch, was outkicked in the final sixteenth but got up in time to earn the show. WELCOME TO AMERICA (IRE) showed good early speed, disputed the pace along the backstretch then set the pace two wide into the turn, was overtaken nearing the quarter marker, chased three wide to upper stretch, faded in the drive and was outfinished for the show honors. STARSHIP MAXIMUS raced close up to the early pace while between rivals, chased into the turn, coaxed three wide to the quarter marker then ran in pursuit four wide to upper stretch, could not find more into the drive and weakened. BALLYCURRIN rated off of the early pace, tracked three wide to the turn, lacked the needed response at the quarter pole and gave way. IN FACT SHEZA ZASK settled in the second flight early on, coaxed along two wide to the quarter marker, chased to upper stretch and did not rally late. STARSHIP POLARIS lacked early speed, trailed to the turn and did not factor.

MESSAGE OF HOPE (IRE) allowed to settle while never far back, tracked the decent pace between rivals into the backstretch, got to the rail heading into the far turn then bid at the quarter marker, took command to upper stretch, kicked clear at the furlong grounds then drew away under late hand urging. TAPSTICK settled away from the start, advanced outside of rivals into the first turn, made a four wide middle move along the backstretch then vied for the lead to the far turn, could not keep pace with the winner into the stretch and was a clear second. LEROY BROWN settled and saved ground to the first turn, was unhurried while not far back through the backstretch run, saved ground to the far turn then angled out to upper stretch, lacked the needed response in the drive but ran on late to earn the show honors. SECRET POWER settled to the first turn, got floated wide entering the backstretch then tracked the pace outside of rivals heading to the half-mile, chased three wide to the quarter marker, could not muster the needed late response in the stretch and just missed for third at the wire. MAGIC RED broke alertly, vied for the early lead inside of rivals then took command into the first turn, set a moderate pace to the half-mile marker, was pressured into the far turn then overtaken nearing the quarter pole, could not keep pace to upper stretch and faded in the lane. ANIMATED broke slowly and was unhurried early on, saved ground along the backstretch, coaxed outside of rivals into the far turn and roused four wide to the quarter pole, could not find the needed response in the stretch and passed tiring rivals late. SAN MARTIN was forwardly placed away from the start, stalked the early pace three deep to the first turn, well placed while tracking along the backstretch run, pressed the pace between rivals into the far turn, lost position approaching the quarter marker and tired in the stretch. ZIO MO was prominent away from the gate, contested the early pace between rivals then stalked the pace into the backstretch, dropped back heading to the far turn, stopped into upper stretch and was not persevered with late.

THIRTY POUND TEST broke a step slowly but recovered to track the early leaders from the outside, pressed the pace three deep into the turn then took command nearing the quarter marker, held off foes into the stretch, dug in into the final sixteenth and proved best in deep stretch. DOGWOOD CROSSING was sent to contest the early pace from inside of rivals, disputed the pace into the turn, lost position nearing the quarter marker, angled three wide to upper stretch and re-bid into the lane, challenged THIRTY POUND TEST into the final sixteenth, was kept at bay by the winner in deep stretch and held safely for second. FIGHTING WORDS raced close up to the early pace, took back and stalked the leaders heading to the turn, chased three then four wide nearing the top of the lane, battled while within range into the final furlong, was outkicked into the final sixteenth and was a clear third. BLAZING TYREEK showed good early speed, disputed the pace between rivals heading up the backstretch, pressed between foes into the turn, chased from the inside at the quarter marker then got put in tight at the top of the stretch, angled out at the furlong grounds, chased to the final sixteenth but faded in deep stretch. VINICIO settled off of the early pace, saved ground to the turn, tracked the leaders to the quarter marker then angled out to upper stretch, ran in pursuit while widest nearing the furlong grounds and could not find the needed late response. LAST SHALL B FIRST hopped then was bumped at the start and was off a bit slowly, lacked early speed, trailed to the quarter marker and did not factor in the stretch drive.

GARUDA rated nicely in the early stages, tracked from the inside heading into the turn, angled three then four wide nearing the quarter marker, loomed to upper stretch and took command into the drive, kicked clear while kept to task into the final furlong and held sway to the wire. PRISM POOL PAT settled off of the contested early pace, shifted out into the turn, was roused three wide at the quarter pole, swung four wide to upper stretch then angled widest at the furlong grounds, closed willingly into the final sixteenth, could not impact the winner late but got up in the final strides for the place honors. GIRL IN BLUE broke alertly and vied for the early lead from between rivals, took back and was well placed heading to the turn, saved ground into the bend then mounted an inside bid at the quarter pole, chased GARUDA into the stretch, was outkicked into the final sixteenth, was nailed on the wire for second and held clearly for third. THE PACKAGE tracked the loose early leader while between rivals, saved ground into the turn then ran in pursuit from the inside heading to the quarter marker, tipped out to upper stretch and responded well into the final furlong, overtook the runner-up into the final sixteenth and edged away in deep stretch. GIGI CAKE'S sent for the early lead, sprinted clear along the backstretch and set her own pace into the turn, held sway to upper stretch, came under pressure past the furlong marker, was caught by the winner in the final sixteenth but held well late for second. OH SHEILA settled off of the early pace while not far back, chased four then three wide into the turn, ran in pursuit to upper stretch, battled while on the left lead into the final furlong, was outkicked in the final sixteenth and held at the wire for third. LOOKS TO KILL tracked the loose early leader from the inside, saved ground to the turn then tipped out to upper stretch, made a sustained bid into the final furlong, was gaining late while between rivals and missed for the minor awards. STEEL CITY LADY got bumped at the start and was off slowly, lacked early speed then advanced outside of rivals into the turn, swung five wide to upper stretch, mounted a mild late rally but could not impact the leaders in the final stages. SHE'S LIT settled off of the early pace while never far back, ran in pursuit three then four wide nearing the quarter pole, lacked the needed response in the stretch and finished evenly. KATHLEEN'S DERBY broke out at the start and was off a step slowly, settled off of the early pace, saved ground into the turn, chased from the two path to upper stretch and did not rally late. THE BEASTER BUNNY settled in the second flight to begin, lost position into the turn and was coaxed along two wide to the quarter marker, shifted to the rail to upper stretch and



did not factor in the late stages. LADY LULLABY chased the early pace, was caught a bit in tight approaching the turn and steadied at the seven-sixteenths, dropped back along the turn and gave way in the stretch.
