BULLDOZE dueled for the lead on the outside of ETON while three to two wide, continued their battle to upper stretch and gained a short lead by the furlong marker and slowly edged clear gamely to prove best under a drive. THE GREAT OSCAR was well rated under a good hold on the inside, moved out and made a three wide bid nearing the quarter pole while being ridden along, then continued on to be slowly gaining late but could not get to the winner while being second best. ETON dueled for the lead on the inside to leaving the turn and then fought on to the furlong marker before fading in the final sixteenth while besting the rest. CHANGE AT JAMAICA had a slight bobble at the start, reserved early on the inside on the first turn, moved out down the backside, four wide advance on the far turn and improved but lacked the needed rally. BIG BOB was taken back early on the inside, advanced five wide on the far turn and passed the tiring rivals. FRIOLENTO was settled on the inside and tired. VOLATILE STORM hit the gate leaving the stall, settled three to two wide and ridden along on the far turn and tired. SWINGING SOLO chased the pace three wide and stopped on the far turn.
