LAIGINA set the pace along the rail, shook clear in upper stretch and widened under a drive. MI AMADA pressed the winner two wide, could not match strides with that foe in upper stretch but kept on to hold the place. STRIKING FINALE stalked the pace three wide, angled in in upper stretch, lacked the needed rally but held for the show. BLAZING BRIDGETTE checked soon after the start, trailed inside for a half, made some progress two wide around the far turn, angled four wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain. CALL THE BULLPEN chased the pace inside and lacked a closing bid. TERRIMENDOUS rated up close two wide around the first turn, chased three deep rounding the far turn and had no response. RIVER BLOSSOM was off a bit slowly, raced three and four wide and never threatened. MINDFUL GRACE played no factor while racing two wide.

LOIS' COURAGE vied between foes down the backstretch, led two wide around the turn, kicked clear in upper stretch but could not withstand the winner late. SWEET SASH raced off the pace four wide and ran on to gain the show. BELLE OF THE SOUTH bumped near the half-mile pole, chased the pace three wide and lacked the needed rally. SPATULA dueled at the rail and gave way midway around the turn. INALLPROBABILITY was outrun inside. AVE FENIX dwelt at the start and trailed inside. THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE START AND TOOK NO ACTION.

soon after and readily drew off. HOT N LUCKY set a clear pace along the rail, was collared by the winner turning for home, could not match strides with the that foe but dug in to hold the place. DRINK N WINK stalked the pace two and three wide, could not keep pace with the winner in upper stretch, battled through the the lane for the place and missed. HYTECK PRINCE raced well back two and three wide, fanned seven wide into the lane and improved position outside. RISK FACTOR chased the pace two and three wide and lacked a closing bid. LAS OLAS trailed inside for five furlongs, went three wide around the far turn, swung eight wide turning for home and passed tiring rivals. TALL STORY raced off the pace three wide, gained four and five wide around the far turn but failed to sustain the bid in the drive. CORTA FUEGO failed to menace while racing two and three wide. WARRIOR WAYNE saved ground off the pace, steadied near the three-eighths marker and never threatened. GIFTEDBYDESIGN played no factor while racing two wide. SECRET BAGENT MAN was outrun inside.

ZEVI'S ZONE chased the early pace and made a two wide move on the turn to be in contention off the bend but proved to be no match for the winner while being second best. SAVAGE WARDEN was bumped and forced to steady shortly after the break then settled into stride along the inside and swung out four wide leaving the turn and ran on willingly to clearly best the rest. CHIMUELO was settled early, three to four wide on the turn and came six wide into the lane and passed the tiring rivals. SCOTTIE TOO HOTTIE was brushed and came in at the start bumping a rival, stalked the pace on the outside and then tracked the leaders three to four wide on the turn and weakened.
