BATTLEOFLEXINGTON got good forward position early, tracked close up on the rail through the middle stages, lacked room through the far turn then had to angle out to the three path mid-stretch, finished well under strong handling and urging and got up despite racing on the left lead through most of the stretch run. RUNAWAY CHARLIE got squeezed at the start then tracked close up to the far turn, followed the path of CAUGHT OFF GUARD into the stretch then was put to strong handling and urging, ducked in just past the furlong marker, took the lead briefly very late but was outfinished by the winner. CAUGHT OFF GUARD pressed RUNNINGFORCASH under a confident from the outset, allowed that rival to dictate the fractions, bid for the lead with three furlongs to run, took a slight lead in upper stretch, kept on gamely to the finish but could not last. RUNNINGFORCASH gained the lead on the first turn and attempted to slow the pace down, had the field bunched up heading into the far turn, was challenged by CAUGHT OFF GUARD with three furlongs to run, battled into upper stretch then weakened in the final furlong. PASTA SALAD RHONDA was allowed to settle from the break and rated kindly behind slow fractions, was being coaxed a bit late on the backstretch run then moved into striking position through the far turn, bid three wide at the quarter pole, quickly went clear and widened the margin with the rider only flagging the crop. LUCY'S LOOKIN LEFT was hustled for forward position and got into a close tracking position three wide, was under a drive approaching the five-sixteenths pole then came under more urgent pressure in the stretch and won the race for second. HOT DAME was sent from the break and able to seize the early lead on the first turn, slowed the pace to a crawl with NO NANNETTE NO keeping company to the inside, led together with that one through the turn were quickly overtaken by PASTA SALAD RHONDA in upper stretch, dueled the first named foe for the second spot but got tagged late. NO NANNETTE NO raced in tandem with HOT DAME through the middle stages, got first run into the stretch, could not go with the winner and was outfinished

for a minor award. WILD TAPIT roused from the break but caught five wide going into the first bend, settled mid-pack then advanced on the pacesetters three wide through the turn, went four wide into the stretch then went one-paced late. SIGNATURE STREET lacked early speed and was last through the early stages, was coaxed to move forward down the backstretch, started a wide sweeping move on the far turn, drifted out to the six or seven path into the stretch and flattened. GOLDEN STORM was caught going five wide into the first turn then was held up for a better trip through the turn, settled at the back of the tracking group through the middle stages, then started to run on after passing the three furlong pole but had nothing to offer in the stretch. JOCELYN raced close up between horses early, was under some coaxing to hold position late on the backstretch run, lost ground on the turn and came up empty in the stretch. CAIRO SUMMER was a little slow to begin and spotted the field a little head start, had one behind coming off the first turn the started to lose ground to the rest and was very far off the pace heading into the far turn, was not persevered with then hopelessly behind. THE RESULTS OF THE PLACE PICK 8 WERE 3/6-4/5-5/6-1/5-4/7-1/5-1/2/4-2/5/8.
