

TWIRLING ROSES hustled away from the gate, settled in a tracking position not far from the leader, moved up to challenge at the five-sixteenths marker, engaged in a spirited stretch duel with GAVEL, was headed late but came back on under a vigorous hand ride and and got up in the final yards. GAVEL allowed to settle from the start, launched a bid with three furlongs to run three wide on the turn, finished well under strong handling, got a head in front late but hung and was outfinished in the last jumps. EYE DEE KAY broke outward at the start and made light contact with GAVEL, moved to the rail when clear then chased from the back through the turn, was put to left handed urging in the stretch but failed to change leads and was unable to find a winning kick. GOLDEN HORNET broke best, assumed command early and opened up a couple of lengths on the rest, responded when challenged on the turn and dug in as three turned into the stretch together, battled gamely to mid-stretch then tired in the final furlong.

HURTS SO BAD broke well and dueled to the outside of WINGING WAYS, gained the advantage past the five-sixteenths marker, finished well under strong handling and urging and held clear to the finish. HATCHET CREEK veered out at the start into WINGING WAYS, tried to go with the dueling leaders early but unable to keep pace, got a rail run though the turn then tipped out to the three path for the stretch run and finished well under strong handling and intermittent urging but came up short. WINGING WAYS got squeezed at the start but still made the front end, dueled with HURTS SO BAD into the turn, then conceded the lead in upper stretch and was outfinished in the late stages. UNCAPTURED PULSE broke well, then tracked two deep to the turn, chased three wide into the stretch, was put to right-handed urging, failed to change leads in the stretch and flattened out. TRY TRY AGAIN dropped far behind after the break, saved ground to no avail and was not involved in the final outcome. SON OF GRACE lost the path and shuffled back at the start, raced three wide down the backstretch, was trying to get out going into the turn then drifted six wide turning into the stretch and was kept to task down the stretch.

BYWORD broke a step slow then was pinballed twice in the initial stages, rushed up two wide on the first turn to grab the lead then went on to open a big lead, extended the margin to double digits on the far turn, was kept to task in the stretch and went unchallenged to the finish despite shortening strides in the final furlong. RAYFIELD was first to the turn but ceded to BYWORD, settled in second seemingly unbothered by the margin to the leader, started to chase that rival from the start of the far turn, was unable to threaten but managed to close the gap a bit at the finish. BLACK RUSSIAN was off a step slow then put in a squeeze a few strides after the break, settled in last through the first turn, then moved out to the four path for the run down the backstretch, went two wide through the turn the swung four wide into the stretch and ran on some in the later stages to gain third. HOLDEN MICHAEL got bumped leaving the gate then floated four wide on the first turn, made a steady advance down the backstretch while under a ride then produced a grinding finish and was unable to improve. MONEY AGENT got a clean break and vied inside for the early lead on the clubhouse turn, ceded the front to BYWORD and settled near the front of the chasing group, came under pressure to keep pace on the turn but was unable to proved much of an effort in the stretch. MALIBU FINALE got roughed up from both sides at the start, settled near the back of the trailing group, was being coaxed near the half-mile pole to go on but did not respond, had nothing to offer in the stretch and was not persevered with in the late stages.

HOT DAME gained the early lead but was shadowed to the far turn by AUTISM COMPASSION, gave way readily when that foe challenged leaving the seven-sixteenths marker, came into the stretch racing on the left lead and finished evenly. SILKY WARRIOR (IRE) steadied going into the first turn then setled three wide down the backstretch ran on some when cued from the three furlong pole then finished with mild interest in the stretch. TALL GIRL raced a bit keenly leaving the gate the was hard to place into the first turn, bid three wide into the stretch but lacked a finishing kick. MEMPHIS CASH QUEEN settled inside, came under pressure on the far turn then had little to offer late.
