INDYVILLE, away well, drafted back nearing the half while four wide and outside foes, emerged as the closest pursuer as a duel went on past the five sixteenths, switched over to his correct lead when set down near the three sixteenths, sustained a grinding run under pressure, took over outside ELI'S PROMISE in deep stretch then cruised home.
