HARPER BRIANA pulled her way between rivals near the half, shifted in a bit and was firmly rated off foes leaving the far turn, worked outward to be four wide into the lane, closed stoutly under pressure and took over outside foes near mid stretch, spurted well clear, bobbled in deep stretch then was under confident handling the final yards. SADIE'S SWEET RIDE stalked the pace while saving ground, moved up along the inner rail to challenge near the three sixteenths, fought on a furlong out then held well to be second best. WAHIDA OF MARDAN saved ground early, angled out mid turn then circled five wide into the stretch, straightened away and closed mildly. TIZMEONEMORETIME stalked the pace, was under asking three wide into the stretch, could not match strides with the outer charging winner in mid stretch, pursued between runners with a sixteenth to go and continued on with effort. DAISY MAE ATTACK rated off the pace while saving ground, steadied briefly entering the turn, angled off the inside in upper stretch, edged up behind a wall of rivals leaving mid stretch, checked off heels, altered out and finished with interest. SKIP TO BALI sped clear early, set the pace two wide into the lane, was joined from both sides, failed to kick on with a sixteenth to go and weakened. CHELA broke outward, was urged up outside a rival nearing the turn but failed to get involved through the final three eighths. SABRE ATTACK, off the pace and outside a rival into the turn, gave way.
