ELI'S PROMISE prompted the early pace to the inside of INDYVILLE, eased back off that one leaving the far turn, responded to asking and came back along the rail to challenge mid turn, sparred into the lane, wrested command near mid stretch, opened up under a couple of left handed asks then was steadily hand ridden through the final seventy yards. INDYVILLE vied outside the winner while under early rating, moved clear past the half, was taken back on near the five sixteenths, sparred on a slim lead and under asking into the stretch, drifted out a bit while unable to match strides in mid stretch, corrected and kept on with effort. CLYDE'S GREEN GO, five wide early, edged up four wide outside runners leaving the far turn, was coaxed along pursuing the dueling leaders into the lane, failed to punch on leaving mid stretch and faded. BILL'S HONOR, forwardly placed four wide between horses, failed to respond near the three eighths and faded. CAMP DADDY, off a bit slow, recovered and moved up to stalk towards the inside, failed to go on under pressure entering the lane and weakened.
