WE MISS ARLINGTON cleared soon after the break, set a rated pace off the inside, met an outer bid from LUCKY SHOT nearing the three eighths, dueled three wide and to the inside of that rival from the head of the lane, asserted himself leaving the sixteenth pole and edged clear late. LUCKY SHOT prompted the pace three wide, moved up to engage the winner leaving the far turn, battled head and head approaching the stretch, entered the lane in the four path while still latched on, could not quite match strides near the sixteenth marker and gave way stubbornly. PLUNDER , off the early pace, came three wide for the drive, worked between rivals leaving the furlong grounds and continued with effort. RUSSIAN TO WIN prompted the pace while saving ground, was under a hearty ride pursuing the embattled leaders into the stretch and faded through the final furlong. DOUBLE THUNDER , urged from the gate, lost ground four to five wide and failed to generate the needed kick. SUPREMEPLY steadied soon after the break, regrouped and edged up four wide to stalk, was under pressure three deep mid turn and faded. GOOD SCOUT , reluctant to load, steadied back out of a tight spot near the five eighths, regrouped and edged up between runners leaving the far turn, gave hard chase into the stretch and weakened.
