LARRY THE POET hustled up into the turn, pressed the pace leaving the quarter pole, found a clear lane five wide leaving the furlong marker, four deep approaching the sixteenth pole, rallied through the final yards up under the wire. RED MOSCATO tracked the pace three wide around the turn, strong drive worked hard to gain ground on stubborn leader leaving the furlong marker, inched clear inside the sixteenth pole, game inside foe denied by the photo. SECESSION broke sharp, set the pace around the turn, collared in deep stretch held on stubbornly for the show money. SHARP STICK raced off the pace to turn, scrubbed on off the rail around the turn, found good energy late, improved through the final sixteenth, needed more to garb a spot on the podium. CANYON SHADOWS buckled at the start, settled off the pace around the turn, cut the corner into the lane, chased on evenly through the final stages. VIA DEL CORSO slow into stride, bid five wide off the pace into the lane, never factored late.
