HARD TO FATHOM, under firm rating stalking along the inside, steadied inside a pair of foes near the half, sat patient leaving the five sixteenths then altered out off heels with run past the three sixteenths, straightened and made a grinding advance on his left lead past the furlong grounds, drifted in under a solid hand ride in deep stretch and just got up between foes. EVEN THE WIND settled off the pace and off the inside into the far turn, angled five wide for the drive, closed gamely outside foes and just missed. SILVER QUARTERS hopped at the break, recovered and settled well back, swung out well in the course for the final furlong and offered a belated run. SOUL COAXING was taken four wide approaching the first turn, pulled his way forward while three deep heading to the half, bid outside the leader leaving the far turn, dueled to about mid stretch and faded. BETWITHBOTHHANDS cleared early, set the pace towards the inside, was joined exiting the far turn, sparred off the rail and to the inside of a rival into the stretch, failed to kick on leaving the furlong grounds and weakened. GOLD SMOKE, three wide stalking the pace, raced between runners into the far turn, failed to go on leaving the five sixteenths and tired through the drive. An objection by the rider of BOURBON LIFE against the winner alleging interference near mid stretch was not allowed.

STAR BLESSING (IRE) bobbled at the break then came in bumping ROARING VIXEN which in turn caused a severe jam up to multiple rivals to her inside, corrected and then cleared early, set the pace under a light hold through the backstretch run, cut the corner into the stretch and held firm while kept to task. POVERTY WITH AVIEW stalked the winner, took closer order nearing the far turn, was under a hearty ride pursuing from the five sixteenths, kept on willingly but failed to make serious headway through the final furlong. ROARING VIXEN, bumped and forced in by the winner leaving the gate, dropped back off the pace while saving ground, angled four wide with some momentum in upper stretch, churned on and out kicked an inner ACOUSTICAT for the show. ACOUSTICAT, roughed between runners leaving the gate, was taken up sharply when in tight towards the rail leaving the seven eighths, regrouped and saved ground, eased out to work between runners near the half, shifted in through the lane and kept on with effort. TRIPLE MOON stumbled inward at the break, corrected and settled off the pace while towards the inside, angled four wide with a mild run into the stretch then flattened out. POLSKA SUE rushed up to contention then steadied when getting out a bit near the six and a half furlong pole, corrected and chased the pace, saved ground into the

stretch and faded. HALFIN checked sharply after being bumped and pinched back at the break, regrouped then checked avoiding a troubled foe around the first turn, came three wide for the drive but was unable to overcome the early adversity. UNKEPT PROMISES, a bit fractious in the gate, was knocked sideways at the start, raced three wide near the half, came four wide for the drive and failed to get involved.
