OH MACARENA prompted the pace while saving ground, edged up to the inside of I BE GONE and put a head in front leaving the half, spurted clear exiting the far turn, denied an outer threat in mid stretch then widened late under a drive. DEAL'EM AND WEEP , brushed at the break, was taken to rate while saving ground into the backstretch, eased out and moved up between foes past the five eighths, picked up serious chase of the winner past the five sixteenths, loomed with a furlong to go, switched over to her left lead, kept on with effort and held down the place. WHAT'S TO DO saved ground, gained under asking past the five sixteenths, angled four wide soon into the lane, pursued past mid stretch then flattened out late. ROYAL LAUGHTER drafted back off the early pace, raced three wide into the lane then showed some late action to the inside of a rival. SPICY ITALIAN stalked three wide, was under pressure into the lane and faded. TWO LUCYS , rank at the break, came in a bit and brushed a rival, dropped off the pace, saved ground approaching the lane and failed to menace. I BE GONE cleared early then wandered to about the four path around the first turn, remained difficult to handle through the backstretch run, ceded command near the half, got out well wide past the three eighths then retreated.

RACETOTHEFINISH , bumped at the break, took a slim lead soon after, secured the inside and set a pressured pace under rating, battled on near even terms with A REAL HERO leaving the five sixteenths, responded to firm asking and shook clear leaving the three sixteenths, increased her advantage past the furlong grounds and was kept alert to the final yards. A REAL HERO saved ground off the embattled leaders, was under a ride mid turn, worked outward for the final furlong, finished up willingly and nabbed the place in the final yards. LOST SUNSET got into a battle outside the winner soon after the start, stayed latched on under pressure around the turn, failed to match strides leaving the three sixteenths, faded through the final seventy yards and lost the place late. RUNNERS HEAT broke outward bumping the winner, corrected and stalked outside A REAL HERO, came three wide for the drive and failed to kick on. JERSEY GOLD , a bit fractious in the gate, dropped off the pace after a furlong, angled out in the lane and failed to generate a response.

JOURNEYIST , taken to rate while saving ground, gathered momentum when put to pressure past the five sixteenths, remained inside with a sustained run to take over in mid stretch, responded to firm asking and drew clear. MY LADY SLEW cleared early, set the pace towards the inside, was shoved along while widening past the three eighths, entered the stretch two wide, dug in after being headed near mid stretch, chased on gamely and saved the place between runners. R KATIEBUG broke slowly, settled off the pace while saving ground, raced inside a pair of rivals leaving the far turn, cut the corner into the stretch and closed willingly. MY BUDDY BROOKS tracked outside while under early rating, was put to a solid ride pursuing the leader past the five sixteenths, took closer order three wide into the stretch, kept on with effort but was edged out for the show. EMPIRICAL VIEW , under firm rating heading to the three quarter pole, raced in the clear nearing the half, angled out and advanced four wide into the stretch, loomed outside foes past the three sixteenths, shifted in leaving mid stretch and flattened out. ROAR OF SILENCE , off the pace, raced between runners into the far turn and failed to respond. COMMISSIONER GULCH saved ground early, was angled out for the backstretch run, raced three deep into the far turn but failed to muster up a run. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
