BLURT sped to a short lead early then handled outer pressure through the backstretch run, was put to a hustling ride leaving the five sixteenths, shook clear two wide soon into the lane, opened up under strong handling in mid stretch then held firm while kept to task. SIXWILLBERICH disputed the pace outside the winner, could not quite match strides while three wide into the lane, gave game chase through the final three sixteenths and dug in for the place. GLOBAL EMPIRE settled off the pace, saved ground with progress into the lane, sustained a run to about the sixteenth marker then flattened out late. MR. UNIVERSE hesitated at the break and was away last, was taken wide for the backstretch run, angled in for the drive but failed to drum up a rally. U S HONOUR NAP broke inward brushing a rival, corrected and pulled his way forward, was stoutly rated along into the backstretch, edged up between foes nearing the half, chased past the five sixteenths, came four wide for the drive and tired. LOOKIN FOR REVENGE, away awkwardly, regrouped and edged up four wide into the first turn, remained wide chasing outside rivals into the far turn, failed to kick on while five wide into the lane and faltered. PLAIN OR PEANUT, brushed at the break, was in close along the rail nearing the turn, dropped well off the pace after a quarter mile and failed to make an impact.
