PROFESSOR HIGGINS saved ground around the first turn, settled in the middle of the pack on the inside for the run up the backstretch, came around the far bend in the three path, launched a bid nearing the quarter pole, kicked clear, and held off a closer to the wire. I O FEDRO brushed lightly with the horse to his inside at the start, saved ground early, raced off the pace up the backstretch, swung out to the four path coming around the far turn, began a bid

entering the stretch and gained ground late to narrowly miss. JUSTICEONEMORETIME saved ground around the first bend, tracked the leader on the inside up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the far turn and chased on while drifting mildly to the finish. KINGSBURRY ATTACK raced off the pace in the two path through the opening half mile, came around the far bend in the two and three path and improved position from there. RAMESSES bumped with the horses to his inside leaving the gate and dropped back to trail the field around the first turn and up the backstretch, saved ground around the second bend and passed tiring horses in the lane. WOLF HUNTER raced in the two path around the first turn, stalked the pace setters on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the far turn still in the two path and faded in the stretch. LONE RETURN brushed with the horse to his outside at the start, saved ground early, led the way on the inside up the backstretch, continued to save ground around the far turn and tired in the lane. MOONRISE DRIVE bumped with the horses to his outside leaving the gate, raced in the middle of the pack in the two path through the opening half mile, saved ground around the far turn and made no bid. ALADANTE bumped repeatedly to the horses to either side at the break, recovered to press the pace on the outside around the first turn and up the backstretch, came around the far bend still in the two path and tired in the stretch.
