SHAKE UP showed speed, ceded to the inner winner, pressed into the turn, failed to match strides leaving the far turn, stayed on to chase to mid stretch then weakened. MIDTERM broke outward brushing a foe, rated back between runners early, saved ground into the lane and came up empty. PONCHO ATTACK, sluggish from the gate, was outrun.
