R KATIEBUG raced in the middle of the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, began a bid entering the stretch, dueled in upper stretch and got up for the win. KANT BELIEVE IT hit the gate leaving it, recovered to lead the way up the backstretch, came around the turn in the two path, dueled in the stretch and gave way late. SECRET OPERATION raced off the pace between horses early, saved ground around the bend, began a bid entering the stretch and improved from there. GRAY LIGHTNING tracked the leaders between horses up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the three path and chased on to the wire. GRACE DARLING (IRE) bumped with the horses to either side leaving the gate, raced at the back of the pack on the outside early, swung out to the five path coming around the bend and never threatened. DEVIL raced off the pace on the inside through the opening quarter, saved ground around the bend and was empty in the lane. EMPIRICAL VIEW bumped with the horse to his inside at the start, raced off the pace up the backstretch, swung out to the

five path coming around the turn and made no bid. SWEET MUSIC raced at the back of the pack on the inside through the opening stages, swung out to the five path coming around the turn and made no bid. MARY'S BOON chased the leader on the inside up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the two path and tired in the stretch. SAMARITA bumped with the horse to his outside lat the break, stalked the leader on the outside up the backstretch, came around the turn in the four path and faded in the lane.
