SHACKLEFORD STRONG dueled on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and drew off in the stretch. RED MOSCATO dueled between horses through the opening quarter, continued to battle from the two path around the bend and could not go with the winner in the stretch but chased on from there. LAVENDER EARL raced in the middle of the pack between horses early, navigated the turn from the two path and improved position in the stretch. HAWAIIAN HIDE AWAY raced in the middle of the pack on the inside up the backstretch, came around the turn in the two path and kept on

from there. TIE BREAKER LENNIE raced in the middle of the pack between horses through the early going, saved ground around the bend and finished evenly. PLAIN OR PEANUT trailed the field up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the three path and passed tiring horses in the lane. GALLANT BUCK chased the leader up the backstretch, came around the turn in the four path and faded in the stretch. GABAGOOOL hit the gate leaving it, raced at the back of the pack on the outside early, began a bid from the five path coming around the turn and flattened out in the lane. CHAMPAGNE MIKE raced in the middle of the pack on the outside up the backstretch, came around the turn in the in the three path and showed no kick. SHAMAN SEZ pressed the pace on the outside up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the three path and tired in the stretch. TALLAPOOSA raced off the pace on the inside through the opening stages, navigated the turn from the three path and made no bid.
