BOCA BEACH CLUB was last to break, but moved up five-wide on the turn, chased HE GONE into the stretch, then wore that rival down in the final furlong and was going away in the end. HE GONE was very quick from the gate, opened up a big lead on the turn, finished up well, but was no match for the winner. LITTLE KRUSH moved up after a bit of a tardy start, chased the top pair through the stretch in vain, but was clear of the next horse. UNION CAIT ducked out after the start into the path of SPARTAN KING, then was well behind the early pace to the stretch, then outfinished the rest but came up short of the minor award. GO CHICAGO broke sharply, briefly cleared the field, then was overtaken by HE GONE, took up midway through the turn, drifted out very wide, lost ground, then made a mild recovery through the stretch run. MR IN PERSONAL chased inside and was outfinished. COPPERJACKET broke out, then took up when HE GONE came over into the path, was near the back after the break, then did not handle the turn and lacked a late bid. SPARTAN KING broke in the air, lost the path, then was hard to handle from the start, lugged in towards the inside rail, nearly making contact with the rail, then hit the rail just before the turn, was taken wide on the turn, eased to the finish, and walked off. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time.
