OK BY ME contested the early pace three-wide, took command before the three-furlong pole, then held well clear the rest of the way. BALI GIRLEE vied inside initially, dropped back at the half, switched to the outside to rebid for the lead into the stretch, chased OK BY ME gamely just ahead of ANNA'S DREAM but could not close the gap. ANNA'S DREAM vied between horses early, then could not go with OK BY ME into the turn, re-engaged with BALI GIRLEE from mid-stretch, dueled to the wire but could not get by and had to settle for third. WARREN'S MEMORABLE raced outside a rival well behind the frontrunners and chased throughout. DULCE AMANECER YG was outrun from the start and was never a threat.

SWEET RETREAT settled along the rail in the middle of the strung-out field for the first half, navigated through the far turn to bid four-wide at the top of the stretch, and outkicked the rest to win clear in the end. RENTON was kept to the back and got over to the rail, angled out to the three-path on the far turn, then swung five-wide into the stretch, rallied mildly to get the place but could not threaten the winner. SHANGHAI CUPID settled in the back half of the field early, had a lot of ground to make up turning for home, but found best stride in the late stages and moved up to gain third. FOLLOW THE STAR tracked ZORRITOS DASH in second position from the outset, gave a good try in the stretch, finished willingly, but was outkicked. ZORRITOS DASH made the early lead as the field lined up single-file behind, kept the rest at bay through the far turn, came into the stretch with a narrow advantage, had something left when called upon in the stretch, but was outfinished. BALLISTIC BOB settled in the middle of the pack then could not find the needed late kick in the stretch.

SENSE OF AWE took control of the race early, kept the rest at bay through the turn, then responded when set down in the stretch and drew clear under steady handling. DIG BABY DIG rushed up to join the early leaders, settled inside with the group chasing SENSE OF AWE, made a run at that one leaving the quarter pole, was no match, but kept on well to be a clear second. MAMA GLOWS dropped to last late on the backstretch, navigated an inside path through the turn, and finished well up the rail to gain third. WILDEST PROBLEM was outrun from the break and dropped far behind early, rallied three-wide through the turn, advanced, but flattened out in the stretch. K K'S FIRST DANCE broke well, contested the early pace between rivals, loomed a threat three-wide turning for home, but weakened in the final furlong and lost position. ASTUTELY raced between the leading pack and the trailers down the backstretch, saved ground into the stretch, but faltered. TIZZIRA pressed the early pace three-wide, struggled to keep pace late on the turn, and had nothing left for the stretch run.

SHORT SPEECH tracked four-wide not far off the pace up the backstretch, launched a bid with three furlongs to run, chased VANCOUVER VALOR into the stretch with WITT'S DUBAI GIRL also a factor to the inside, gradually wore down both foes in the late stages and prevailed in the last jumps. VANCOUVER VALOR broke well, made the lead and led the way into the turn with the rest in close pursuit, opened up a bit at the quarter pole, had SHORT SPEECH giving chase to the outside, finished gamely ahead of rivals to both sides in the final furlong but yielded in the last jumps. WITT'S DUBAI GAL away in good order, tracked close up on the inside, steadied slightly before the quarter pole, finished up well, but was not quite good enough. GLORY ALL THE TIME raced in the middle of the compact field, never far back, kept to the inside through the turn but was outkicked in the stretch. HOLIDAY CRUISE dropped to the back after a level start, tried to rally three-wide through the turn but was unable to threaten. EVIL TOM broke on top, dueled with VANCOUVER VALOR three-deep to the turn, dropped out before the three-furlong pole and had nothing to offer in the stretch.

SIPPIN SCOTCH hustled away and secured the early lead, leaving the chute, proceeded to dictate moderate fractions while being left alone on the lead, quickened heading into the far turn, while maintaining a clear advantage, responded when set down in earnest at the top of the lane, and held sway under steady handling to prevail. BINARY CODE was rank passing the stands the first time and continued to fight the rider through the first turn, settled down up the backstretch, raced up close to the stretch, then produced a strong finish to just miss. ROMAN EAGLE broke in and made some light contact with WHISKEY OVER ICE, secured a rail position and tucked in behind the pace through the early stages, bided time without a clear path to the stretch, had the winner get first run, but finished up well to take the third prize. GRIND JIM was unhurried from the start and settled at the back of the pack, advanced closer on the far turn, then made a nice late run to improve while never becoming a serious threat. JUST BERNIE got forward position but was hung out three to four wide on both turns, finished up with some interest but could not produce the needed late kick. FLY RED BIRD FLY was very fractious in the gate, got caught four-wide on the clubhouse turn, settled wide in the middle of the pack, was able to quicken with the pace on the far turn, then had a problem with the lead change in the stretch and flattened out. AIR OF GHURAIR got shuffled back after the start, had only one horse behind turning onto the main

course, bided time through the middle stages, then went six or seven wide into the stretch but was unable to improve. DAPILOT raced close up in the middle of the field to the stretch, then lacked a finish. WHISKEY OVER ICE got bumped at the start, then raced near the back, then never offered a rally and finished well behind the rest.
