SUN THE SANDS broke well and tracked WMA GETAWAY through the early stages, pulled even a the 7/16 , started to assert dominance late on the turn then drew away in the stretch as much the best. MAJD STORM ducked in sharply and slammed into BURNING JEWELS causing that one to fall and unseating the rider, was well back of the rest down the backstretch then was put to intermittent right handed urging on the turn, drifted wide on the last turn taking WMA WILD KISSES out as well, finished with good energy to gain the second spot. WMA GETAWAY was quickest from the gate and sped off to a clear early lead, was joined by SUN THE SANDS at the seven-sixteenth pole, readily gave way to that one approaching the quarter pole kept on but was unable to save the place. WMA WILD KISSES lacked early speed and was far behind the rest before the turn, switched to the outside then was floated very wide on the last bend by MAJD STORM, ran on some in the stretch and managed to split the strung out field. FLYING J STORM mid-pack early, made a mild middle move then lost focus approaching the stretch and was not a factor in the late stages. WMA SANDY BEAR was away well and tracked three wide lost ground on the turn and had little to offer late. BURNING JEWELS took a hard bump from MAJD STORM at the start, clipped heels, stumbled badly and lost the rider, was caught by the outrider and walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT AT THE START AND THERE WAS A TRAINER'S OBJECTION REGARDING THE SAME MATTER. AFTER REVIEW, THE OBJECTION WAS UPHELD, #5 MAJD STORM WAS DISQUALIFIED FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE START AND PLACED LAST.

RISKY WITH WHISKEY was hustled from the inside and established a clear lead, maintained through the turn then dug in when KARANTHOS made a challenge leaving the quarter pole, engaged that foe in a spirited duel the length of the stretch and could not be separated at the finish. KARANTHOS came away well and tracked RISKY WITH WHISKEY down the backstretch, went to put some pressure on near the quarter pole then went head-to-head with that rival down the lane and was on even terms at the wire. AUDREY'S MUSIC was a little slow into stride then made a mild advance through the turn then kept on well despite racing on the left lead in the stretch and earned the third placing. CAUSE MIMI SAID settled at the back of the pack through the early running, saved ground through the turn then went two wide into the turn and ran on some late but was not good enough. WORK ZONE raced in the middle of the tracking group then came under a ride on the turn but was outfinished. MISCHIEF MAC was inside with the tracking group then was close up through the turn without a path forward, did not respond when asked at the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. OH AND GEE raced three wide down the backstretch, retreated under pressure on the turn and chased far back to the finish.

CONTOUR was allowed to settle in last through the early stages, advanced on the field on the far turn and finished with a bold rally to win going away despite wandering a bit in the late stages. ARINNITI (FR) made the lead crossing onto the main course, was left to dictate moderate fractions, led the way to the stretch, repelled a bid by CACTUS BLOSSOM from the quarter pole but could not fend off a late bid by CONTOUR but saved the place. CACTUS BLOSSOM was pulling hard up the chute then took up a stalking position behind ARINNITI (FR), launched a bid approaching the quarter pole, had some trouble changing leads turning into the stretch, went flat and finished evenly under urging. CONTRABBANDA settled mid-pack under a hold, was not asked until approaching the stretch then was gaining some despite lugging in. CLAIRE JUNE raced close up on the inside just behind ARINNITI (FR) then dropped off the pace late on the far turn and hand little to offer in the stretch. BRAD'S SWEETHEART raced two wide near the pack of the pack and lacked a rally. GIRLS GOT GAME was not asked for speed from the break, settled near the back of the field and showed little throughout.

CINCO RICHIE veered out at the start causing a chain reaction of bumping to the outside, then was forwardly placed early just behind the pacesetters, crept closer as the field advanced down the backstretch then was poised to make a move on the far turn but lacked a clear path, got free in upper stretch tipped three wide and responded to strong handling and urging and was just up in time. COASTAL BRINK got a clean break then took up a stalking position behind PERRY COUNTY through the early stages, bid for the lead about three furlongs from the finish, found that rival resurgent, battled through the stretch, had trouble keeping a straight course late, drifted in near the sixteenth pole and just failed to hold off the winner in the final yards. MOON CAT tracked at the head of the second flight to the far turn, then launched a bid from the three furlong marker, got a rail run through the far turn, responded to strong handling and intermittent urging but came up a little short in a solid effort. PERRY COUNTY broke in and bumped YOU'RE ON MUTE then was squeezed as several horses converged in the middle of the start, still made the lead turning on to the main course then was left to dictate moderate early fractions while under a light hold, had COASTAL BRINK lapped on the outside down the backstretch then dug in when that foe moved to challenge on the far turn, was holding steady down the stretch then had to steady at the sixteenth pole and lost all chance. SARGE'S SERMON was bumped by MY CALANTE right after the

break then took another bump from the inside a few strides later, settled three deep with the tracking group, then bided time down the backstretch, advanced to the first flight through the turn, then finished up well under strong handling was not enough. EXCAPING THE BLUES raced close up three wide with the forward group, came under a ride from the three furlong marker, turned in an even effort late while unable to pose a serious threat. YOU'RE ON MUTE took the worst of the bumping at the start, lost the path and shuffled back, saved ground while racing with the tracking group, finished with a mild gain up the rail without being a serious threat. SHAMAYIM got crowd at the start by the bumping to the inside, then pinched back by TIGERS 'N BEARS, took up and altered course to the inside, raced near the back with only TIGERS 'N BEARS behind, was kept to task down the stretch but was unable to improve. MY CALANTE broke in at the start and made light contact with SARGE'S SERMON, race two wide in the middle of the second flight to the far turn, did not respond when asked to go on from the three furlong marker and was unable to mount a rally in the stretch. TIGERS 'N BEARS took a bump as part of the mess at the start, then was devoid of early speed and trailed far behind then was not persevered with late when hopelessly behind. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
