TAKE ACTION was off a step slow then hustled into the early pace mix, put a head in front passing the half-mile marker, vied inside of a pair of foes also intent on contesting the pace, pulled ahead past the quarter pole and had a clear lead turning for home, opened up then easily held off a late bid from a rival. FORT HOOD got pinballed at the start then tracked the pace from the rail to the turn, emerged from the pack in the stretch with a late bid but could not get to the winner while far ahead of the third horse. HEZAKOOLKAT pressed the pace three wide then was unable to go on from the quarter pole, kept on well to hold third. TALK ABOUT AUTISM raced three wide with the second group, continued that path through the turn then ran on some late while never a serious threat. BOLSHIE was between horses in the tracking group, dropped back to last on the turn then came back on under steady urging but could not make an impact. STRAIGHT LUCK broke in and made contact with FORT HOOD then vied between horses through the early stages, struggled to keep up after passing the quarter pole then hand little to offer in the stretch.

COLONEL YORKE broke sharply and vied for the early lead without really being asked then was allowed to dictate the pace as the rest lined up behind, slowed the middle splits while continuing to lead the way, started to edge away from the field leaving the quarter pole then quickened when cued at the top of the stretch, went well clear and cruised to the wire under wraps late. SILVER ASSASSIN settled in the middle of the pack in cover through the early stages, bided time through the far turn with no options to get out., got free in upper stretch and finished up well under steady handling and was easily second best while no match for the winner. MISTER MOSCATO got over to the inside and was unhurried through the first half of the race, stayed on the rail path down the backstretch and the far turn, waited behind horses to the stretch, got clear run with a furlong to run and surged late to gain the third spot. KING ARTHUR RIDGE was unhurried from the start and settled on the rail near the rear of the field, went two wide through the far turn then swung four wide into the stretch and finished with good energy while never a serious threat. GHURAIR'S WARRIOR was forwardly placed three wide into the first turn then remained in the clear down the backstretch no too far from the front, launched a bid with about three furlongs to run, went four wide on the far turn and finished evenly. SILVER STEF HIT tracked close up on the inside then took up the chase when COLONEL YORKE slipped away from the pack, then could not sustain the bid and was outkicked in the final furlong. UPTOWN TAPPIN raced inside with the tracking group saved ground throughout but could not find the needed response in the stretch. GOLDEN GRIT hopped at the start, then raced three to four wide on both turns and was unable to menace. GOD'S GOLD was outrun from the start, trailed to the far turn then was put to some urging in the stretch and managed to pass one late. CRAZY RIDGE raced close up three wide to the far turn, dropped out of contention late on the turn and was eased to the finish.

BLUE LIGHT was allowed to settle from the break then cruised up to join the leaders on the inside, backed off the pace a bit on the turn then came back on under a drive two wide into the stretch, finished strong under steady handling, ran right by CHASING TIME in mid-stretch and won going away. CHASING TIME took the early initiative and had a head in front to the turn while traveling well in hand, responded when asked to go on from the quarter pole and opened up in the stretch, was finishing evenly when confronted by BLUE LIGHT in mid-stretch, gave way readily and held second. BIG BERNIE vied for the lead between horses to the turn, remained a factor to the stretch then was outfinished. WITHOUT A TRACE pressed the pace three wide came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly but could not improve. TIZ FABULOUS raced close up to the turn, then started a steady fade and was distanced in the end.

WOW THAT'S HOT had good speed from the break and made the lead under a light hold, then was left to set reasonable fractions to the far turn, turned back a bid from STEEN at the top of the stretch then pulled clear in the final furlong to win as much the best. ROUSTABOUT broke well and close up in the run down the backstretch, made an early three wide bid for the lead heading into the turn the had to be ridden to keep up before passing the quarter pole and was outrun in the stretch.

NO TROUBLE vied for the early lead then settled in a stalking position covered up behind the pacesetting pair, had nowhere to go through the far turn then split horses at the furlong marker, gained the lead and held sway under a strong hand ride and steady urging. SINGING DIXIE took the worst of the start and got shuffled back to last at the start, advanced steadily down the backstretch and into the far turn then loomed six wide into the stretch, ran on well under strong handling and just missed in a driving finish. ZE'BUL got squeezed at the start then was held up at the rear of the field early, waited until the stretch before launching a bid, took the rail path in the stretch, squeezed through along the rail in deep stretch and close stoutly only to come up short in a good effort. BROOKLYN ALLEY CAT was unhurried early and settled behind the main forward pack, launched a three wide bid on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, was finishing well under left handed urging then put in tight in the last sixteenth. SUMMER LOVER broke out at the start and caused a chain reaction to the three horses in adjacent stalls, then was guided to the front and secured the rail going into the first turn, stalked while stuck in side with no escape path down the backstretch, remained in the same position into the stretch then took advantage of the gap passing the chute, finished willingly but was outkicked to the wire. WHISKEY WITH YOU was always close up with the forward group, got a clean run into the stretch, ran on well but was outfinished in the late stages. IRISH KITTEN was always close up, traded the lead with BRILLIANT SPIN down the backstretch and into the far turn, kept on well when challenged on all sides at the top of the stretch but weakened late. BRILLIANT SPIN was away well then was three wide turning onto the main

course but gained the lead under a hold before the first turn, ceded to IRISH KITTEN down the backstretch but pressed to the inside, put a head in front at the quarter pole then was overtaken from all sides in the stretch. SUPREME LEADER was least affected by the mess at the start, then coaxed to forward position down the chute then tracked three wide around the clubhouse turn, was close up into the far turn the came under heavy right handed pressure nearing the quarter pole and had little to give in the stretch.
